

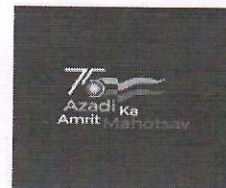

Subject: Inviting entries and Rules & Regulations for participation in Inter Collegiate tournaments of the University for the year 2022-23

The Directorate of Students' Welfare is organizing the Inter Collegiate tournaments/competition during the academic calendar year 2022-23. In this regard, entries from the affiliated institutes/colleges are invited for participating in Inter Collegiate Tournament for the following Sports:

1. March Past (Mandatory for all participating affiliated institutes)
2. Cricket
3. Volleyball
4. Basketball
5. Badminton
6. Football
7. Lawn Tennis
8. Athletics
9. Cross Country Race
10. Yoga
11. Kabaddi
12. Tug of War
13. Power Lifting (Only for Men)
14. Weight Lifting (Only for Men)
15. Body building (only for Men)
16. Chess
17. Table Tennis

All the Principals/Directors of affiliated college/institute are requested to motivate the students to participate in the aforesaid tournaments. The procedure for submission of entry and other rules are as under:

1. Submission of Entries:

- (a) The entries duly completed in the prescribed Performa (Annexure-1) should be submitted in the office of the Directorate of Students' Welfare on or before 28th November, 2022. Entries for participating shall not be entertained after due date.
- (b) Each affiliated college is entitled to enter only one team for each sport in tournament.

2. Identity Card

Each member of a team participating in an inter-college tournament shall carry identity card which shall bear the following as approved by the college.

- (a) Photograph of the player & his/her signature.
- (b) Attestation of the photograph under the seal by the Director / Principal of the College.

The player(s) not carrying identity cards shall not be allowed to participate in the concerned tournament.

3. Inter College Participants

- (a) No request for participants shall be entertained without the players eligibility Performa. All the teams/athletes will be permitted to participate in inter-college tournaments only with proper playing kit.
- (b) All the teams/participants should report at the venue an hour before scheduled time for the commencement of the tournament/match.
- (c) All the teams shall have to be accompanied by a team manager who may be a Physical Education Faculty member / Faculty member/ Coach of the college deputed by the Principal/Director. The name of the manager with his/her designation should be entered in the eligibility performa and only such person has the right to perform the duty of the Team Manager. If the team is accompanied by a coach or any other person (other than the Manager), the Principal should authorize person with a letter of authority. No unauthorized persons shall act as the team manager or coach.
- (d) Under no circumstances a team be allowed to participate in a tournament unless accompanied by a team manager/coach.
- (e) The manager should submit two copies of eligibility certificate in the prescribed Proforma (Annexure-2) duly filled and signed by the Principal/Director at the venue an hour before scheduled time for the commencement of the tournament/match. All columns of the eligibility certificate have to be filled. No over writing or correction is permitted in the eligibility Proforma.
- (f) The participants should also produce the college identity card duly signed by the Principal at the time of the competition.
- (g) Only permitted number of students/actual participants needs to be entered in the eligibility Proforma.
- (h) If a team withdraws from the championship after giving the entry/drawing the fixture with valid reasons, they should inform the matter to the Director, Students' Welfare well in advance.
- (i) Students undergoing disciplinary action in the institute/colleges will not be allowed to participate in the inter college tournaments.

4. Fixture and Draw

- (a) All the championships will be conducted on knock out basis.
- (b) The fixture for championship will be drawn one week before the tournament.
- (c) All the colleges that send entries before the last date prescribed shall be included in the draw only.
- (d) The fixture will be uploaded on the University Website under Notices / Circulars.
- (e) Coaches and students have to check university website at regular intervals for further information.
- (f) The entire tournament will take place according to the rules in force.

5. Eligibility Rules


- (a) Age limit of the students shall be maximum up to 27 years for this academic session. Further, student may participate if he/she is less than 27 years of age as on 1st July of the current academic year
- (b) Only a bonafide, full time student, existing on the rolls of the University during academic year 2022-23, shall be eligible to participate in the tournament.

6. Protest

- (a) The decision of the referees/umpires shall be final. Only the participating teams representative appointed by college are allowed to lodge their protest (on the official letter head), if any, within one hour against any matter other than the decision of the referees.
- (b) The protest received after the prescribed time limit shall not be entertained.
- (c) University will constitute a jury of appeal from time to time and the decision in the matter of protest shall be final and binding on all the teams and the participants.

7. Indiscipline & Misconduct:


- (a) Any member of the team/manager/coach found involved in the acts of indiscipline or misconduct shall be liable for disciplinary action. In cases where acts of indiscipline/misconduct are committed by more than one team members/with the abetment of other team member/manager/coach the liability shall be of the entire team. For any breach of discipline / misconduct, concerned college team shall be debarred from participation in any Inter collegiate tournaments meet for upto 03 years. Loss or damage caused to personal property of any participant or University shall be recovered from the concerned institute.
