Introduction

This document describes the curriculum of the Diploma in French at the University School of Humanities and Social Sciences at GGSIP University Dwarka Campus and affiliated institutions of the University.

In the event of any difficulty in implementing, and / or interpretation of any clause of the document, the same may be brought to the notice of Dean, University School of Humanities and Social Sciences. The decision of the Dean, University School of Humanities and Social Sciences shall be final and implemented to resolve the issue. The same shall be put up in the subsequent meeting of the Board of Studies of the University School of Humanities and Social Sciences for its approval. If the decision of the Board of Studies of the University School of Humanities and Social Sciences is at variance with the decision taken earlier by the Dean of the School, the decision of the Board shall be effective from the date of the approval by the Board of Studies. In the interim period (between the approval of the Dean, of the School and the Board of Studies approval), the decision already taken by the Dean of the school shall stand.

The **intake** in the programme shall be **40** with the addition of supernumerary seats as per the policy of the university.

Programme Outcomes

PO 1 (Knowledge): The programme will provide students with an opportunity to the French language and grammar. The programme shall focus on imparting reading, writing and speaking skills among students.

PO 2 (Understanding): The programme will help students understand the French language and grammar. The programme shall focus on imparting reading, writing and speaking skills among students.

PO 3 (Communication): The programme envisions to enable students to read and write French and express themselves in the French language

Definitions, Eligibility, and Duration of the Programme

Semester/Credits:

- An academic year is divided into two semesters.
- A semester comprises 15 weeks.

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Duration:

- After the successful completion of **120 hrs** spread over two semesters, a student will be awarded the Certificate in the French.
- After the successful completion of **240 hrs** spread over four semesters, a student will be awarded the Diploma in the French.

Eligibility:

- The minimum requirement to get admission in a Diploma in French Language shall be 10+2 with at least 50% marks on merit basis.
- There shall be no entrance test for admission to Diploma in French Language.
- Eligibility for direct admission to Semester 3: The candidate must have completed Certificate in French or should have done any equivalent course.
