### **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE FEMALE STUDENTS (UG, PG STUDENTS OF USIC&T) IN STEM FIELDS UNDER MERIT CUM MEANS SCHOLARSHIP SPONSORED BY HATCH**

The USIC&T, GGS Indraprastha University proposes to grant financial assistance sponsored by HATCH India, a platinum member of Canada's best managed companies, to support the meritorious female students pursuing UG and PG programs in different branches of engineering and technology at USIC&T, belonging to the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) of the society. The purpose of the scheme is to encourage Females to pursue higher education in STEM fields and financially support the Female students belonging to Economically Weaker Section of the Society.

Hatch is a global engineering company with headquarters in Canada and a global network of 9,000 professionals. Hatch has experience in the metals, energy, infrastructure, digital and investments market sectors, across 150 countries around the globe, and is an organization passionately committed to the pursuit of a better world through positive change. Hatch has expressed interest to provide financial assistance to the meritorious female student/s, from economically weaker section of society (under Merit cum Means scholarship), pursuing education in UG, PG programmes at USIC&T GGS Indraprastha University.

The USIC&T and HATCH have jointly evolved an objective and transparent mechanism to assess the eligibility of the students for this scheme.

#### **1. THE KEY FEATURES OF THE SCHEME:**

The scheme is open to all the Girls UG/PG students of USIC&T who fulfill the eligibility criteria as laid down herein below. The maximum limit of financial assistance given to an applicant will not be more than **Rs. 75,000/- in an academic year.**

The beneficiary of the scholarship shall be UG and PG Girl students of USIC&T, with at least two Girl students from each branch of engineering i.e. B.Tech (IT, CSE, ECE), at least one Girl from each M.Tech (IT, CSE, ECE) program and two from MCA program.

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

- i. The applicant should be a regular full time female student of the USIC&T, GGS Indraprastha University and should have scored **minimum 60% marks throughout** her previous semesters. The scheme is not applicable for 1<sup>st</sup> year Female students of any discipline.
- ii. The income of the family from all sources, to which the applicant belongs should not be more than Rs. 8,00,000/- per annum.

- iii. The applicant/applicant's family should hold a family Income Certificate issued by the SDM or any other officer authorized in this behalf by the Revenue Department the total annual income of the family is not more than Rs. 8,00,000/-. The date mentioned on the Income Certificate should be valid as per the Govt. norms on the date of issue of the notice of EWS Scheme.
- iv. An applicant availing any kind of financial assistance or scholarship from any other sources of the Government or otherwise shall be eligible for grant of financial assistance. However, in all such cases, the amount of financial assistance being availed by the applicant from other sources shall be deducted from the total amount of financial assistance recommended by the committee under the EWS Scheme.
- v. Following students/applicants shall not be eligible for grant of financial assistance under this scheme:
- a) The student who has the status of failure in any of the subjects in any of the semesters on the last date of submission of application form.
  - b) The applicant detained in any semester examination of the course due to shortage of attendance.
  - c) The applicant penalized by the University or the institutes for any act of indiscipline during the course.
- vi. Every applicant shall be required to submit an application, with all requisite documents enclosed, on or before the closing date of this scheme to the office of the Dean USIC&T for processing.

### **3. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:**

- i. Duly filled application form.
- ii. Copy of the family Income Certificate issued by the Area SDM or other officer authorized in this behalf by the Revenue Department of the Government. The date mentioned on the Income Certificate should be valid as per the Govt. norms on the date of issue of the notice of EWS Scheme.
- iii. Mark-sheets of all previous academic qualifications from class-X onwards.
- iv. In case of old students, copy of all semesters examination of the University.
- v. Copy of latest fee receipts issued by the University.
- vi. Copy of Aadhaar Card of student and seeding of aadhaar with the bank account of the student.
- vii. Copy of passbook and a cancelled cheque of saving bank account of applicant for remittance of financial assistance, if granted, by the University directly to the student's bank account. The Bank Account should be in the name of student. Name of student, bank account no. & IFSC Code must be mentioned on the copy of passbook/cheque.
- viii. All the documents, testimonials submitted with the application form should be self-attested and duly verified by the concerned Course Coordinator.
