Subject: Call for applications for outgoing staff mobility for teaching to Cracow University of Economics, Poland under Erasmus+ programme

The University has entered into an Inter-Institutional agreement 2019/20-2020/21 with Cracow University of Economics (CUE) under Erasmus+ Programme. As part of the programme, an outgoing staff mobility for teaching (funded by the programme) is available. The mobility is open to full-time faculty members of the University (having PhD degree) from the field of Economics or Finance. Under the mobility, the faculty shall stay at CUE for five days and teach an 8-hour course (to be developed by the faculty and approved by CUE). Faculty members interested to apply for the position should have taught at least one course of Economics and/or Finance over the last two years (2017-18, 2018-19). The candidates are advised to develop an outline for the course proposed to be delivered by them at CUE. It is expected that the candidates have published research papers related to the said course in journals with impact factor (Web of Science).

Full-time faculty of the University from the field of Economics or Finance, interested in availing the outgoing staff mobility for teaching, are invited to apply (routed through Dean of the concerned school). The applications must contain the following documents:

1. Copy of PhD degree;
2. Statement of purpose (SoP) for applying for the mobility;
3. Proposed course outline supported by relevant research in the area; and
4. List (and copy) of publications during 2017-18 and 2018-19 (clearly indicating the impact factor, if any).

The applications may be submitted by 24th January, 2020 in the Directorate of International Affairs, Room No. 306, D-Block, GGSIP University campus.
