1.	Scholarship for Graduation/ diploma. Applicant must be enrolled in a 3- year graduation/ diploma programme.	INIR 30 000/ non reas
2.	Scholarship for Undergraduate engineering. Applicant must be enrolled in any recognized Undergraduate engineering programme.	INR 30,000/- per year for four years.
-3.	Scholarship for Vocational courses. Applicant must be enrolled in any Vocational course.	INR 20,000/- per year for one year.
4.	Scholarship for Individuals helping others. Applicant must be involved in activities like teaching/training (academics or sports) a group of unprivileged children.	INR 75,000/- per year for two years.
5.	Scholarship for Sports persons. Applicant must be ranked within 500 at National or 100 at state or 10 at district level for a particular sport.	INR 75,000/- per year for three years.

General Eligibility Conditions:

- An applicant must have passed class 12th Board Examination in 2019 with minimum 60% marks.
- She/he must be enrolled for a programme at a recognized institution of India.
- Annual family income should be less than Rs. Five Lakhs (Rs. 5,00,000/-) only from all sources.
- Candidates belonging to Divyangjan category are required to furnish 'Disability Certificate' in line with the provisions of the Disability Act.

The scholarships are open to Indian Nationals who fulfill the eligibility criteria specific for a particular scheme. The last date of application is 30th Jan'2020 and students can apply online at www.colgate.com/keepindiasmiling.
