1. **Seat Allocation in Delhi and Outside Delhi Region**

For clarification on Region i.e. Delhi or Outside Delhi, candidates may please refer to the Chapter 5 : 'Seat Allocation', Part-A, Admission Brochure 2020-21.

Note:

The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination through Distance / Open Education system of any recognized University / Board and fail to provide the proof of his / her study centre being located in Delhi shall not be considered for Delhi region seats, and shall be considered for admission in the Outside Delhi Region, if seats available.

FOR OBC CERTIFICATE: The non-creamy layer certificate should be issued on or after 31st March, 2020. However for Central Government Institutions, seat allocation is on all India basis among the category of seats including OBC and for such reservation the certificate issued should as per the central list of OBC and the non creamy layer certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2020.

Further, however for Delhi Government Institutions, The reservation for OBC Category is only for candidates who are from Delhi Region (The candidates who have studied 10+2 class in the recognized School/College in Delhi and passed the qualifying examination from any School /College located in Delhi shall fall under 'Delhi Region Category'). A certificate issued by a Competent Authority of Delhi to the candidate on the basis of Caste Certificate of his/her parents from another state will be accepted for claiming a seat under OBC Category if and only if the caste is in the list of notified OBC list by Govt. of NCT of Delhi and the non creamy layer certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2020.

2. **Reservation Policy**

Candidates shall please refer to the Sub Point 6.1 of Chapter 6: 'Reservation Policy', Part-A, Admission Brochure 2020-21.

3. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION**

Pass in 12th class of 10+2 of CBSE with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) or equivalent with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology provided that the candidate has passed in each subject separately. The candidate must also have passed English (core or elective or functional) in qualifying examination.

4. **Fees:**

Bank Draft(s) of Rs. 20625/- (including Rs. 1,000 non-refundable counselling participation fee) is required at the time counselling in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, payable at Delhi. The candidate will write his name, date of admission, phone, address, mobile no, name of the programme, CET Rank and CET Roll Number on the back of the Bank Draft(s). Balance fee (if applicable) shall be paid by the candidate at the allotted institute.

Documents Required for Verification and Allotment of Seats

- a) Filled Admission verification form as per Appendix 4A of Part E of Admission Brochure 2020-21.
- b) Filled Preference sheet as per Appendix 7 of Part E of Admission Brochure 2020-21.
- c) Four passport sized photographs (same as that in admit card)
- d) CET Rank Card/Merit Order of CET-2020 (copy)

- e) CET-2020 Admit Card (in original) 2020.
- f) Proof of date of birth (Secondary School Mark-sheet & Certificate) (Original and Photocopy)
- g) Mark-sheets / Certificates of qualifying examination:
- h) The candidate will be required to bring the Original certificates/Mark-sheets of all the year wise or semester wise in original along with photocopy of Certificates/ Mark-sheets of qualifying examination.
- i) For Distance / Open Learning Cases:
In case of students who have passed the qualifying examination through distance / open education system of any recognized University / Board / Institution, the necessary documentary evidence related to location of his / her study centre i.e. study centre proof, certificate from the University imparting open / distance education certifying the location of the study centre to be submitted.
- j) Physical Fitness Certificate:
All the students shall be required to submit a Medical Certificate indicating fitness from a Registered Medical Practitioner as per format given in Performa of Medical Certificate in given in Part-E in Admission Brochure 2020-21 (As per Appendix 6).
- k) Reserved Category Certificate:
All reservation category candidates who are seeking admission in reserved category in SC / ST / DEF / PWD / OBC/EWS must bring their reservation certificate (the caste/category certificate should invariably be in the name of candidate himself/herself and not in favour of respective parents/ guardians) in original along with the self attested photocopy of the certificate for claiming seat against the reserved category. **The Defence Category candidates, in addition to all the documents, shall also bring Appendix 1 duly completed. The appendices are available in Part E of Admission Brochure 2020-21.**
- l) Conduct and Character Certificate in original from the Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from Gazetted officer in Original, not more than 06 (six) months old.
- m) Application regarding age or any other relaxation with necessary approval (if necessary).
- n) The required Certificate(s) for reserved categories / classes will be essential at the time of the counselling / admission and no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate from the local competent authority. Further, the caste / category certificate should invariably be in the name of the candidate himself / herself and not in favour of respective parents / guardians.

Important Note:

l) **REGARDING CORRECTION, IF ANY, TO BE CARRIED OUT: ATTENTION:**

All Qualified CET Candidates (CET Code 115) seeking admission in programme in Academic Session 2020-21: All such CET qualified candidates are hereby informed that keeping in larger interest of candidates, who are still approaching the University for correction to be carried out in Date of Birth, Spelling mistake in name or the parent's name or in the Choice of Category claimed for the purpose of availing reservation in the submitted CET form / application and Others etc., they have to submit the request application in physical form. The candidate must submit the copy of request Application along with documentary proof in original in support of change in the Admissions Branch, GGSIP University, Dwarka, Sector 16-C, New Delhi-110078 on working days between 10:00 a.m. to 04.00 p.m. till start of the conduct of 1st Round of Counselling. It is clarified that no such request for correction / change will be accepted on the day of Counselling. All concerned may please note that this is an opportunity given to the candidates seeking correction in the details so filled in the CET form.

5. It will also be the sole responsibility of the candidates themselves to make sure that they are eligible and fulfill all the conditions prescribed for admission. Before filling-up the verification slip at the time of verification of documents/counselling/allotment of seats, candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils all eligibility conditions as laid down in the respective Admission Brochure for the session 2020-21. If it is found at any stage during the entire period of the programme that the candidate does not fulfill the requisite eligibility conditions, his/her admission will be cancelled and also disciplinary action will be initiated against his/her and entire fee will also be forfeited.

6. **Seat Matrix:** Region wise and category wise seat matrix will be informed well before the commencement of counselling.

7. **Withdrawal of Admission**

Last Date of Withdrawal is 28.12.2020. The refund shall be processed as per the notified Refund Policy 2020-21 of the University, shall mandatorily be submitted in the prescribed format available in Part B, Admission Brochure 2020-21, (Appendix-8). The same shall be submitted in the Admissions Branch, Administrative Block, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, Sector 16 C, Dwarka, New Delhi – 110078. A proper receipt for withdrawal will be issued in lieu thereof. It is once again informed that the request for withdrawal has to be made in the Admissions Branch, GGSIPU only and in the prescribed format necessarily.

All the refund application shall be processed in accordance with the Refund Policy notified in the Part C Chapter 15 of Admission Brochure 2020-21 or as per the latest guidelines of UGC.
