**DETAILED SCHEDULE REGARDING 2<sup>ND</sup> ROUND OF OFFLINE STATE COUNSELING FOR VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS AND ALLOTMENT OF SEATS IN BHMS (CET CODE 154) IN DR. B R SUR HOMEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGE, HOSPITAL & RESEARCH, NEW DELHI (AFFILIATED TO GGSIP UNIVERSITY) FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2020-21.**

***[THE GGSIP UNIVERSITY SHALL CONDUCT THE COUNSELLING FOR 85% OF STATE QUOTA SEATS FOR WHICH ONLY THE CANDIDATES WHO HAVE PASSED THEIR QUALIFYING EXAM FROM DELHI SHALL BE ELIGIBLE.]***

With reference to the University notices cited above, it is brought to the notice of all the concerned candidates/stake holders that the verification of the documents pertaining to the reserved category (i.e. SC/ST/OBC/DEF/PWD) and allotment of seats in 2<sup>nd</sup> round of Offline State Counseling for BHMS (CET CODE 154) programme for the academic session 2020-21 shall be carried out on 07.01.2021 in GGSIP University Campus, Sector 16C, Dwarka, New Delhi – 110075 as detailed below.

Please note that the admission to BHMS (CET CODE 154) for Academic Session 2020-21 shall be made on the basis of the NEET UG 2020 All India Rank. The NEET UG 2020 qualified candidates who have registered in GGSIP University for admission in BHMS (CET CODE 154) programme shall report in person for verification of documents and allotment of seats at the venue of the counselling on the specified date and time mentioned as per the schedule. However, actual merit shall be ascertained and admissions shall be made accordingly.

In order to be eligible for admission to Undergraduate courses for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate minimum marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the "NEET" for undergraduate courses for the said academic courses as per Central Council of Homeopathy, New Delhi notification dated 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 which is at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for SC/ST & OBC and for candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile for general category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

[Counselling for the seats reserved for any Region / Category shall be stopped as and when the seats in / of such Category / Region are filled up.

2. **SEAT MATRIX:** The number of vacant seats to be filled up through 2<sup>nd</sup> round of counseling through GGSIP University under State Quota counseling in **DR. B R SUR HOMEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGE, HOSPITAL & RESEARCH**, will be made available at the counseling venue before the start of the counseling.

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3. **FEEES TO BE PAID AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING/ALLOTMENT OF SEAT IN THE UNIVERSITY**, a candidate will mandatorily bring a Demand Draft of Rs. 41,000/- (Rs. 40,000/- + Rs. 1,000 non-refundable counselling participation fee) in the name of **Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, payable at Delhi.**

4. **DATE AND TIME OF REPORTING IN THE ALLOTTED COLLEGE: 12<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2021**

All the candidates admitted in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of counseling shall report in the allotted college latest by **12.01.2021** (as per the Time Schedule for completion of Admission process for BAMS/BHMS for the academic year 2020-21 and onwards). Any candidate, who shall not report to the allotted college within the stipulated period, shall be considered as withdrawn. However, the refund shall be eligible as per the norms of the University/Statutory Body.

5. **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES CLAIMING RESERVATION:-**

- (a) In case candidate wishes to claim seat in **Delhi Region Category**, then he/she must provide proof of having passed 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> standard (under 10+2 scheme) certificate from **any school located in Delhi only**.
- (b) The candidate seeking admission under reserved categories has to mandatorily make available the entitled supporting certificate in his/her name. The certificate in name of either of the parent (Mother/Father) is not acceptable and the candidate shall not be entitled to claim benefit for admission against reserved seat. **The University will not consider any claim for allotment of seat in the reserved category on the basis of any undertaking.**
- (c) The reservation certificate should be issued from the respective state/region in which the reservation is claimed.
- (d) **Guidelines for candidates claiming reservation Under PH/PWD Category:** The guidelines regarding admission of students with "**Specified Disabilities**" under the Rights of person with disability Act, 2006 (49 of 2016) in BAMS and BHMS shall be applicable as provided in the Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM), New Delhi notification dated 18<sup>th</sup> June 2019 and Central Council of Homeopathy (CCH), New Delhi notification dated 19<sup>th</sup> June 2019 respectively available under public domain on the CCIM & CCH website.
- (e) In case the candidate is claiming the seat reserved for Delhi OBC/Delhi SC/Delhi ST category, then, he/she should have passed his/ her qualifying exam from any school located in **Delhi only** and must have OBC/SC/ST certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

The benefit of reservation shall also be extended to all candidates who hold SC certificates issued from GNCTD provided such caste is enlisted in the list of Scheduled Caste as specified in Presidential Order 1951 as amended from time to time in respect of Delhi subject to fulfilment of other conditions specified therein. Please refer to the Annexure 'A' attached to this notification. Such candidates whose certificate has been issued by competent authority in GNCTD but their castes do not fall in Delhi, as specified in the Presidential Order 1951 (Annexure A above) shall not be considered for admission against seats reserved for '**Delhi Region Category**'.



- (f) The Reservation for Delhi OBC is applicable only in University School of Studies and Govt. affiliated Colleges only. The OBC reservation shall be at the Undergraduate level only of 27%. Same as above, a certificate issued by a competent authority of Delhi, will be accepted for claiming seat in OBC category if and only if the caste is in the list of notified OBC list by Govt of NCT of Delhi for claiming benefit of 'Delhi Region OBC'. **THE NON-CREAMY LAYER CERTIFICATE SHOULD BE ISSUED AFTER 31<sup>ST</sup> March, 2020.** Please refer to the Annexure 'B' attached to this notification. - (g) The Reservation for EWS is applicable in Govt. affiliated Colleges. This will be implemented in accordance with the Govt. of India and Govt. of NCT of Delhi orders as applicable. For more details please refer Chapter 6.1.7 of the Admission Brochure 2020-21 available on the University website [www.ipu.ac.in](http://www.ipu.ac.in).

**Reserved Category Candidates who fail to produce the adequate documents as per notified schedule will forfeit his/her right for the category claimed and will automatically be treated as General Category as per University rules.**

#### **6. ELIGIBILITY CONDITION FOR BHMS PROGRAMME:**

**Candidate must have passed 12<sup>th</sup> class examination in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtain a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the qualifying examination mentioned above for Unreserved Candidates and 40% in respect of SC/ST/OBC. Candidate with benchmark disabilities as specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be 45% for General Category and 40% for SC/ST/OBC.**

#### **Admission Criteria:**

**All candidates must appear in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test –Undergraduate of 2020 (NEET UG 2020) and qualify to be considered for admissions.**

**Further, to become eligible for 85% Delhi Quota, the candidate must have passed 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> examination under 10+2 system conducted by (CBSE, ISCE/Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi or any other equivalent examination recognized by the University of Delhi for admission to under graduate courses from a recognized school situated within NCT of Delhi only.**

**The candidates who have passed 12<sup>th</sup> examination from Patrachar Vidyalaya or National Institute of Open Schooling will be eligible for admission in BHMS courses under 85% Delhi Quota provided their study center and the examination center were within the National Capital Territory of Delhi and they must submit a certificate from the controlling authority of Patrachar Vidyalaya/NIOS in this regard. However, the candidature of candidates who have passed 10+2 from NIOS or state of open school or as private candidates from recognized State Boards; or with Biology/Biotechnology as additional subject shall be allowed subject to the outcome of the Special Leave Petitions/Appeals filed by Medical Council of India.**

**The Second Counselling will commence from 'NEET ALL INDIA RANK' 01 onwards for all categories and the seats will be allotted strictly on the basis of merit. The candidates who were absent in the first counselling will also be permitted to attend the second counselling. Admission will be made strictly on merit basis and the counselling / admissions will stop when all the seats get filled up. Parents / candidates are advised to check University's website for notices before coming for counselling to avoid any inconvenience.**



**Notes:**

- (a) If the seats of sub-categories (i.e. Defence and PWD/PH) remain vacant, then they shall first be reverted to that respective parent category.
- (b) Thereafter, the conversion of SC, ST, OBC to General Category shall be done only during the 2<sup>nd</sup> counselling. While converting the seats in 2<sup>nd</sup> round, any unfilled seat reserved for ST category will be offered to SC category and vice versa and only after completing this exercise, the conversion of the reserved category seats to General Category shall be effected.
- (c) All the candidates claiming seats in Defence Priority (I to IX) shall visit the University on the notified date and time. The University will call the candidates priority wise for verification of documents and allotment of seats within the notified date and time.
- (d) The total number of seats tentatively vacant to be filled up in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of Offline counseling through GGSIP University in respect of the affiliated college shall be displayed before the start of the counseling. **All the candidates have been called to ensure that no seat remain vacant. However, the counselling shall stop as and when the seats are filled up.**
- (e) **Any category candidate, who have/have not been called and/or whose vacancy does not depict in the 'vacancy position' may attend the counselling as an unreserved category candidate.**

**7. ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION IN 2<sup>ND</sup> ROUND:**

Fresh candidates, all those candidates who did not get any seat allotment during 1<sup>st</sup> Round of Counselling; withdrawn candidates subsequent to allotment in 1<sup>st</sup> Round; allotted but not joined in their respective colleges, shall be eligible to participate in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Counselling.


**9. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING / ADMISSIONS:**

All eligible candidates shall bring the following documents in original along with an attested or self attested copy of the each at the time of Counselling/Admission.

- i) NEET UG 2020 Admit Card
- ii) NEET UG 2020 Score Card
- iii) Copy of GGSIPU Registration Form
- iv) Four passport size photographs
- v) Demand Draft(s) of Requisite Fee in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University payable at Delhi. Details are mentioned below. Write the name of the candidate, name of the programme on the back of Demand Draft (s).
- vi) Copy of Admission verification form (duly filled by candidate as per Appendix 4(B) given in Admission Brochure 2020-21.
- vii) Preference Sheet (duly filled by candidate as per Appendix 7 given in Admission Brochure 2020-21.
- viii) Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Certificate for verification of date of birth;
- ix) Certificate and Marksheets of the qualifying examination issued by the Board/University.
- x) In case candidate wishes to claim seat in Delhi Region category then he/she must bring proof of having passed qualifying examination also from Delhi.
- xi) Character Certificate from the head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination was passed or from Gazetted Officer.
- xii) SC/ST/OBC/DEF/PWD/EWS etc. Certificate, if applicable (Original and One Photocopy).
- xiii) Appendix 1, as given in the Admission Brochure 2020-21 along with the relevant entitled certificates, if admission is claimed in Defence Category.
- xiv) Medical Certificate (as per Appendix 6, Admission Brochure 2020-21).
- xv) The candidate has to be present in person for the purpose of verification of documents and allotment of seats as the schedule.
- xvi) The candidate must produce original certificate for the purpose of verification of documents and allotment of seats and in case he has taken admission somewhere else and deposited the documents, then he/she should submit a written proof from the concerned college/institution/university for the same.

Any other terms and conditions as defined by the Statutory body/Competent Authority, shall be applicable for counseling process/admission to BHMS programme for academic session 2020-21.
