DETAILED SCHEDULE REGARDING MOP-UP ROUND OF OFFLINE STATE COUNSELING FOR VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS AND ALLOTMENT OF SEATS IN <u>BAMS (CET CODE 153)</u> IN <u>CH. BRAHM PRAKASH AYURVED CHARAK SANSTHAN</u>, NEW DELHI (AFFILIATED TO GGSIP UNIVERSITY) FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2020-21.

[THE GGSIP UNIVERSITY SHALL CONDUCT THE COUNSELLING FOR 85% OF STATE QUOTA SEATS FOR WHICH ONLY THE CANDIDATES WHO HAVE PASSED THEIR QUALIFYING EXAM FROM DELHI SHALL BE ELIGIBLE.]

With references to the University notices cited above, it is brought to the notice of all the concerned candidates/stake holders that the verification of the documents and allotment of seats against the vacant seats in Mop-Up round of Offline State Counseling for BAMS (CET CODE 153) programme for the academic session 2020-21 shall be carried out on 15.03.2021 in GGSIP University Campus, Sector

16C, Dwarka, New Delhi - 110075 as detailed below:

Please note that the admission to BAMS (CET CODE 153) for Academic Session 2020-21 shall be made on the basis of the NEET UG 2020 merit. The NEET UG 2020 qualified candidates who have registered in GGSIP University for admission in BAMS (CET CODE 153) programme, shall report in person for verification of documents and allotment of seats at the venue of the counselling and date and time mentioned as per the schedule. However, actual merit shall be ascertained at the time of counselling and admissions shall be made accordingly.

With reference to the letter received from the Under Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India vide no. F.No. L-11011/1/2020-EP-1 Part 1 dated 20.01.2021, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum 40th percentile in the "NEET UG 2020" for Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homeopathy UG courses, which is 30th percentile for SC/ST & OBC and OBC PH, SC PH & ST PH, 35th percentile for UR/EWS & PH candidates.

<u>VENUE OF COUNSELING</u>: GURU GOBIND SINGH INDRAPRASTHA UNIVERSITY CAMPUS, SECTOR -16C, DWARKA, NEW DELHI.

The Candidate must read the schedule carefully.

- → The Candidates who did not register are not eligible for Counselling.
- → The candidates whose name reflects in the "List of candidates in-eligible for participation in UG Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homeopathy (ASU&H) State Quota/UT quota/Institutional Quota/Nominated seat counselling 2020- Reg." received from Under Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of AYUSH vide no. F.No. L-11011/02/2020-EP-(1) dated 19.01.2021, are not eligible for participation in the counselling conducted by the University.

1. <u>SEAT MATRIX</u>: The tentative number of seats to be filled up through the Mop-Up round of counseling through GGSIP University under State Quota counseling in <u>CH. BRAHM PRAKASH AYURVED</u> CHARAK SANSTHAN, as on date, are as per details given below.

GEN (DELHI) - 1

Candidates who have studied 10+2 (11th and 12th) classes in the recognized School/College in Delhi and passed the qualifying examination from any School/College located in Delhi are eligible for counselling only. As such, the candidate shall produce 11th and 12th certificate issued by the recognized School/College, located in Delhi only.

2. FEES TO BE PAID AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING/ALLOTMENT OF SEAT IN THE UNIVERSITY, a candidate will mandatorily bring a Demand Draft of Rs. 41,000/- (Rs. 40,000/- + Rs. 1,000 non-refundable counselling participation fee) in the name of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, payable at Delhi.

All the candidates are advised to get their Demand Draft prepared and complete their documents well before the counselling dates to avoid any inconvenience.

All the candidates have been called to ensure that no seat remains vacant. The counselling shall stop as and when the seats are filled up.

[Counselling for the seats reserved for any Category shall be stopped as and when the seats in / of such Category are filled up.

4. DATE AND TIME OF REPORTING IN THE ALLOTTED COLLGE: 15TH MARCH 2021

All the candidates admitted in the Mop Up round of counseling shall report in the allotted college latest by 15.03.2021 (as per the letter of the Under Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of AYUSH dated 23.02.2021).

5. ELIGIBILITY CONDITION FOR BAMS PROGRAMME:

Candidate must have passed 12th class examination in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtain a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the qualifying examination mentioned above for Unreserved Candidates and 40% in respect of SC/ST/OBC. Candidate with benckmark disabilities as specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be 45% for General Category and 40% for SC/ST/OBC.

Admission Criteria:

All candidates must have appeared in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test -Undergraduate of 2020 (NEET UG 2020) and qualify to be considered for admissions.

Further, to become eligible for admission under 85% Delhi Quota seats, the candidate must have passed 11th and 12th examination under 10+2 system conducted by (CBSE, ISCE/Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi or any other equivalent examination recognized by the University of Delhi for admission to under graduate courses from a recognized school situated within NCT of Delhi only.

The candidates who have passed 12th examination from Patrachar Vidyalaya or National Institute of Open Schooling will be eligible for admission in BAMS courses under 85% Delhi Quota provided their study center and the examination center were within the National Capital Territory of Delhi and they must submit a certificate from the controlling authority of Patrachar Vidyalaya/NIOS in this regard. However, the candidature of candidates who have passed 10+2 from NIOS or state of open school or as private candidates from recognized State Boards; or with Biology/Biotechnology as additional subject shall be allowed subject to the outcome of the Special Leave Petitions/Appeals filed by Medical Council of India.

The Mop Up round will commence from 'NEET ALL INDIA RANK' 01 onwards for all categories and the seats will be allotted strictly on the basis of merit. The candidates who were absent in the first and second counselling will also be permitted to attend the Mop Up round of counselling. Admission will be made strictly on merit basis and the counselling / admissions will stop when all the seats get filled up. Parents / candidates are advised to check University's website for notices before coming for counselling to avoid any inconvenience.

Notes:

(a) The total number of seats tentatively vacant to be filled up in the Mop Up round of Offline counseling through GGSIP University in respect of the affiliated college shall be displayed before the start of the counseling. All the candidates have been called to ensure that no seat remain vacant. However, the counselling shall stop as and when the seats are filled up.

6. ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION IN MOP-UP ROUND:

Candidates who are registered with GGSIPU and who did not get any seat in BAMS programme through any rounds of Counselling (State Quota/All India Quota); withdrawn candidates subsequent to allotment in 1st Round and 2nd Round; allotted but not joined in their respective colleges, shall be eligible to participate in the Mop-Up Round of Counselling.

7. AGE LIMIT AND AGE RELAXATION: Refer Chapter 3.6, Admission Brochure 2020-21.

All eligible candidates shall bring the following documents in original along with an attested or self attested copy of the each at the time of Counselling/Admission.

- v) Demand Draft(s) of Rs. 41,000/- in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University payable at Delhi. Details are mentioned below. Write the name of the candidate, name of the programme on the back of Demand Draft (s).
- vi) Copy of Admission verification form (duly filled by candidate as per Appendix 4(B) given in Admission Brochure 2020-21.
- vii) Preference Sheet (duly filled by candidate as per Appendix 7 given in Admission Brochure 2020-21.
- viii) Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Certificate for verification of date of birth;
- ix) Certificate and Marksheets of the qualifying examination issued by the Board/University.
- x) In case candidate wishes to claim seat in Delhi Region category then he/she must bring proof of having passed qualifying examination also from Delhi.

- xi) Character Certificate from the head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination was passed or from Gazetted Officer.

 - xiii) The candidate has to be present in person for the purpose of verification of documents and allotment of seats as the schedule.
- xiv)The candidate must produce original certificate for the purpose of verification of documents and allotment of seats and in case he has taken admission somewhere else and deposited the documents, then he/she should submit a written proof from the concerned college/institution/university for the same.

Any other terms and conditions as defined by the Statutory body/Competent Authority, shall be applicable for counseling process/admission to BAMS programme for academic session 2020-21.
