With changing lifestyle, improved longevity and better control of infectious diseases, non-communicable diseases have emerged as major health problems worldwide, more so in developing countries like India. According to Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), Bengaluru, India, more than 2.25 million cases of cancer were estimated to be diagnosed in 2019. This burden is likely to become double in the next 20 years. Almost 75-80 per cent of patients have advanced disease (Stage 3-4) at the time of diagnosis. This has been attributed to the late presentation which in turn is due to low level of awareness in the country. Given the continued growth in the number of persons with Cancer in the world, the primary prevention of cancer remains an urgent public health priority. As the field of cancer prevention continues to mature and scientific knowledge evolves, it is imperative to challenge the disease and embrace new approaches to cancer prevention.
