#### NOTICE

DETAILED SCHEDULE REGARDING MOP UP ROUND OF OFFLINE STATE COUNSELING FOR VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS AND ALLOTMENT OF SEATS IN PGAC (MD/MS AYURVEDA) (CODE 196) IN CH. BRAHM PRAKASH AYURVED CHARAK SANSTHAN, NEW DELHI (AFFILIATED TO GGSIP UNIVERSITY) FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2020-21.

THIS INFORMATION NOTICE IS BEING NOTIFIED FOR ADMISSION ON THE VACANT SEATS IN '50% STATE QUOTA' AND 'TRANSFER OF NON-REPORTING & NON JOINING VACANT SEATS OF AIQG, AIQGA, AIQP TO STATE QUOTA' IN PROGRAMME PGAC (CODE 196) 2020-21.

THE GGSIP UNIVERSITY SHALL CONDUCT THE COUNSELLING FOR 50% STATE QUOTA SEATS FOR WHICH ONLY THE CANDIDATES WHO HAVE PASSED THEIR QUALIFYING EXAM FROM GGSIPU SHALL BE ELIGIBLE.

With references to the above, it is brought to the notice of all the concerned candidates/stake holders that the verification of the documents and allotment of seats against the vacant seats in Mop-Up round of Offline State Counseling for PGAC (CODE 196) programme for the academic session 2020-21 shall be carried out on 20.03.2021 in GGSIP University Campus, Sector 16C, Dwarka, New Delhi – 110075 as detailed below:

VENUE OF COUNSELLING: GGSIP UNIVERSITY, SEC 16C, DWARKA, NEW DELHI.

DATE OF COUNSELLING: 20.03.2021 (02:30 p.m.)

1. Only the candidates who have passed qualifying examination i.e. BAMS from GGSIP University and already registered with the University and are not holding a seat in any stream of PG Ayurveda through any rounds of counselling by allotment through AIQ (conducted by AACCC) 2020-21, are eligible to participate in this Offline State Quota Counselling of GGSIPU.

It may please be noted that the candidates who have not qualified AIAPGET 2020 and/or are not registered with GGSIPU, are not eligible to participate in the counseling.

- 2. The candidate has to be present in person for the purpose of verification of documents and allotment of seats as per the schedule. The candidate must produce original certificate for the purpose of verification of documents and allotment of seats. Candidates without original certificate/documents shall not be allowed to take admission.
- 3. TENTATIVE VACANT SEATS FOR MOP-UP ROUND OF COUNSELLING AS ON DATE (INCLUDING TRANSFER OF NON-REPORTING & NON JOINING VACANT SEATS OF AIQG, AIQGA, AIQP TO STATE QUOTA):

The final vacancy status (if any additional received) shall be displayed at the venue on the date of counselling.

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4. FEES TO BE PAID AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING/ALLOTMENT OF SEAT IN THE UNIVERSITY, a candidate will mandatorily bring a Demand Draft of Rs. 41,000/- (Rs. 40,000/- + Rs. 1,000 non-refundable counselling participation fee) in the name of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, payable at Delhi.

All the candidates are advised to get their Demand Draft prepared and complete their documents well before the counselling dates to avoid any inconvenience.

5. ROSTER POINT: A separate roster shall be followed for admission on the State Quota seats conducted by GGSIP University. The roster shall be continued from roster point number where the counselling was closed in the Academic Session 2020-21 i.e. the Roster Point shall start from 64.

Since the roster point cannot be left blank, the conversion of seat of a category will be during the counselling itself.

### 6. SCHEDULE FOR MOP UP ROUND OF COUNSELLING FOR 'STATE QUOTA SEATS'

### NOTE:

- (a) Only the candidates registered with GGSIPU, have passed their qualifying examination i.e. BAMS from GGSIP University and have qualified AIAPGET 2020, are eligible to participate in the Offline State Quota Counselling for admission to PGAC 2020-21.
- (b) The Candidates who did not register are not eligible for the Counselling.
- (c) The candidates whose name reflects in the "List of candidates in-eligible for participation in PG Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homeopathy (ASU&H) State Quota/UT quota/Institutional Quota/Nominated seat counselling 2020- Reg." received from Under Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of AYUSH vide no. F.No. L-11011/2/2020-EP(1) Vol.-2 dated 18.02.2021, are not eligible for participation in the counselling conducted by the University.

Any other provisions as applicable as per the Statutory Body.

(d) All the registered candidates, irrespective of Rank and Categories, have been called to ensure that no seat remains vacant. However, THE COUNSELLING SHALL STOP AS AND WHEN THE SEATS AER FILLED UP.

# 7. DATE AND TIME OF REPORTING IN THE ALLOTTED COLLGE: 20<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2021

All the candidates admitted in the Mop Up round of counseling shall report in the allotted college latest by 20.03.2021 (as per the letter of the Under Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of AYUSH dated 08.03.2021).

- 8. ELIGIBILITY CONDITION FOR PGAC PROGRAMME: Candidates should have qualified BAMS from GGSIP University. All candidates must appear in AIA-PGET 2020 conducted by AYUSH for the appropriate branch and qualify to be considered for admissions.
- OUALIFYING MARKS/CUT OFF PERCENTILE: In order to be eligible for admission to PGAC, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks of percentile in the AIAPGET

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2020 as per the minimum marks of percentile mentioned in the Central Council of Indian Medicine notification which is 50<sup>th</sup> percentile for General Category, 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for SC/ST/OBC, candidate with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49/2016), the minimum marks shall be 45th percentile for the General Category and 40th percentile for the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Other Backward Classes.

### 10. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

i) CLARIFICATION OF SCHEDULED CASTE CATEGORY CERTIFICATE: It is seen that some SC category certificates issued by competent authority of NCT of Delhi has a clause stating that this certificate is issued on the basis of certificate of parent issued by competent authority of a State / UT other than NCT of Delhi. The benefit of reservation shall also be extended to all candidates who hold SC certificates issued from GNCTD provided such caste is enlisted in the list of Scheduled Caste as specified in Presidential Order 1951 as amended from time to time in respect of Delhi subject to fulfillment of other conditions specified therein.

Such candidates whose certificate has been issued by competent authority in GNCTD but their castes do not fall in Delhi, as specified in the Presidential Order 1951 shall not be considered for admission against seats reserved for 'Delhi Region Category'.

ii) CLARIFICATION ON OTHER BACKWARD CLASS: There shall be no OBC reservation in PGAC. Only SC/ST/PWD/General reservation shall be applicable. Refer Chapter 6 of Part A, pg. 125, clause 6.1.4 of the Admission Brochure 2020-21.

The reservation certificate should be in the name of the candidate seeking admission. The reservation certificate in the name either of parents (Father/Mother) is not acceptable. The name and other particulars in the reservation certificate should be identical to that in registration form as well as in the 10th & 12th class certificates. Any variation in the name or other particulars in reserved category certificate may lead to refusal for admission by admission officer in the reserved category. In absence of reserved category certificate, the candidate will not be entitled for any provisional admission in reserved category on the basis of any undertaking.

The required certificate(s) for reserved categories/classes will be essential at the time of the counselling/admission and no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate. Further, the caste/category certificate should invariably be in the name of the candidate himself/herself and not in favour of respective parents/guardians.

- 11. AGE LIMIT AND AGE RELAXATION: Refer Chapter 3.6, Part A, Admission Brochure 2020-21.
- 12. GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES CLAIMING RESERVATION UNDER PH/PWD CATEGORY: The guidelines regarding admission of students with "Specified Disabilities" under the Rights of person with disability Act, 2006 (49 of 2016) in PGAC shall be applicable as provided in the Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM), New Delhi notification dated 24th July, 2019 respectively available under public domain on the CCIM & CCH website.
