About the programme

This capacity-building programme is designed to offer hands-on experience to researchers in social science discipline. The programme specifically emphasizes on employing a range of qualitative, quantitative and mixed-methods techniques in social science research. The programme focuses on using these techniques to tackle the economic and social difficulties on both micro- and macro-scale. Additionally, the programme intends to incorporate and promote interdisciplinarity in various phases of the research process, right from identifying the research problem, to designing the research, collecting the data, assessing the progress, and preparing the final report. The best practices from various fields of study in the area of social science shall be discussed to illustrate how the research techniques can be effectively employed for sustainable development of society, environment and humankind as a whole. In addition, hands-on sessions shall be conducted to train the participants in qualitative and quantitative analysis using software like IBM-SPSS, IBM-AMOS, R, Stata, Matlab and Max QDA.

Course delivery mode

The programme shall be conducted in the physical mode. Multiple aspects of research methodologies and techniques shall be covered using various pedagogical approaches, such as lectures, hands-on training, and assignments given to the participants. At the conclusion of the workshop, the participants will be required to submit a report.

Eligibility criteria for participants

The programme shall be open to Doctoral Scholars, Post-Doctoral Scholars, Research Associates, Assistant Professors, and Associate Professors in UGC-

recognized Indian universities, deemed universities, colleges, institutes of national importance, or ICSSR Research Institutes. The number of seats is limited to 30 (including ten from Delhi, ten from rest of the NCR, and ten from other states/UTs).

How to apply

Interested candidates can apply by filling up the registration form on or before **November 02, 2022**. The Shortlisted participants will be informed of the decision within a fortnight of the deadline. The registration forms may be filled online at https://forms.gle/Vd2fbdmWsBgRfxgD6. - 3. Research statement contextualizing the current research problems of the applicant with the theme of this CBP (not more than 2 pages)
- 4. A copy of Caste/Community certificate of ST/SC/OBC/Minority.
- 5. Full Covid-19 vaccination certificate.

Participants are required to bring laptop for practical sessions.

Applications received after the due date shall not be considered.

There is no registration fee for the selected participants.


