**RESERVED CATEGORY CANDIDATES:**


This is for information of all the concerned that during the ongoing verification of documents of Reserved Category Candidates, queries have been raised on individual portal seeking clarification for removal of discrepancies in respective programmes. However, it is seen that inspite of raising discrepancy, many of the applicants are not responding to such queries till date which will result in rejecting their claim for reservation of seat in the respective programme..

In order to be eligible to participate in the Online Rounds of counselling/allotment of seats for 2021-22, it is necessary for the Reserved Category candidates to respond to the raised queries by providing sufficient documents to support their claim for reservation. Therefore, it is a gentle reminder to all such concerned applicants who have not yet responded to the raised queries to please do the same by uploading the required and appropriate document latest by Monday i.e. 17.01.2022, failing which, his/her claim for reservation shall be rejected. Also, his/her candidature shall be debarred from participation/allotment of seats as reserved category candidate in the respective programmes for the academic session 2021-22.

**UN-RESERVED CATEGORY CANDIDATES:**

It is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ensure that they fulfill the eligibility criteria in the programmes they seek admission as laid down in the Admission Brochure 2021-22 regarding the correctness of the details filled with respect to Region or any other such details for allotment of seat. For claiming seats of Delhi Region Category/Quota, the candidates should have studied and passed 10+2 (11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>) class from any School/College located in Delhi only. In case of NIOS, the proof of study centre is mandatory. If at any stage during the entire period of admission procedure or later, the information furnished by the candidate is found to be incorrect or untrue, his/her admission will be cancelled and also disciplinary action will be initiated against him/her and the entire fee will also be forfeited.
