## Report

The objective of the workshop was to update the participants about the set of practices, an individual must perform regularly to keep the sensitive data secure. Also, the workshop would be very useful for the day-to-day routine work as well as for profession growth of the employees.

The workshop observed informative sessions delivered by two experienced guest speakers, enlightening the attendees with practical and valuable insights of the said topic. Throughout the sessions, various aspects pertaining to subject were discussed by our esteemed speakers.

The resource persons for the one-day workshop on "Cyber Hygiene" were two very eminent persons. First speaker was Prof Charu Malhotra, Professor (e-Governance and ICT), Lead Coordinator (Centre of e-Governance) at Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi and the second speaker of the conference was Dr. Rakshit Tandon, Founder/Director: HackerShala / CodesNag, (Hackdev Technology Pvt Ltd.), Consultant-Internet and Mobile Association of India, Head Capacity Building- Cyber Peace Foundation. Dr Rakshit Tandon is assisting 29 state police department in cracking various cyber-crime including Haryana Police, Bihar Police etc. In this cyber hygiene workshop not only the preventive measures were discussed, but also how to report if something happens were also explained in detail using many case studies. ".

Prof. Arvinder Kaur, Chairperson, SDC express her gratitude to distinguished speakers for accepting the request to deliver the session. Honourable Vice Chancellor sir could not attend the inauguration session due to his prior commitments, however, he conveyed his best wishes to the participants. Convenor Dr Anuradha Chug welcomed speakers and participants and explained the objective of conducting such workshop.

Prof Charu Malhotra briefed the participants that Cybersecurity becomes the need of the hour for every individual around the world and this is the right time to educate ourselves about the cyber-crime happening around us. She also updated the participants that there are certain things which are above technology which has social impacts, human impacts, mental and physical impacts that we need to understand. How this technology existed, what kind of vulnerabilities are present and how to keep ourselves safe from cyber-crimes and above all if something happens, how to take it forward.

Dr Rakshit Tandon told the participants that one can use the National Cyber Crime Reporting portal to report cyber-crimes related to women & children and other online crimes like financial frauds, ransom ware, etc. He also stated that one can file a complaint against any cybercrime irrespective of where the crime occurred. He further explained that as we are

living in a digital era, where we access the internet at our fingertips while we know about advantages there are some disadvantages too.

To help people stay safe from becoming a victim of cyber-crime, there are some precautions that one could take such as, using a strong password, never disclose account details to anyone or any personal data to someone on the internet or on the phone, use a trusted anti-virus, never send credit/debit card details on any untrusted sites, Protect Wi-Fi. With this the workshop came to an end. The participants were thrilled as they have learned a lot about cyber security.
