## NOTICE

Following are the General Guidelines for Technical Clubs/ Societies for USIC&T Students starting Academic Session 2024-25:-

- 1. The B.Tech students admitted in the first year of USIC&T will be required to choose a primary technical club/ society (only one) from amongst the following list of the clubs/societies:
  - GGSIP USS ACM Student Chapter (Coordinators: Dr. Jaspreeti Singh & Dr. Ruchi Sehrawat)
  - IEEE Student Chapter (Coordinators: Dr. Ashish Payal & Dr. Kamaldeep Kaur) (ii)
  - (iii) Software Development Cell (Coordinator: Prof. Pravin Chandra)
  - TechSpace (Coordinators: Dr. Ashish Payal, Dr. Reena Gupta & Mr. Shiv Ram Meena) (iv)
  - IDEA Club (Conducted by AICTE IDEA Lab) (Coordinators: Prof. Amit Prakash Singh, Dr. Ruchi (v) Sehrawat, DR. M. K. Satyarthi)
  - Institution Innovation Council (IIC-GGSIPU) (University Coordinator: Prof. Amit Prakash Singh; (vi) Department Coordinator: Mr. Shiv Ram Meena)
  - (vii) NSS/NCC (Dr. Priyanka Bhutani)
  - Clubs headed by Directorate of Students Welfare (DSW)
- 2. The students are required to complete the registration formalities of the chosen primary club/society and submit their registration details to the respective teacher in-charge before 01st of October of the admission year.
- The students will be evaluated yearly for the active involvement (on the basis of participation/volunteering/ as being core organizers)in the activities/events of their primary club.
- The distribution of marks on the yearly basis is as follows:
  - Evaluation out of 30 marks at the end of 1st year (i)
  - (ii) Evaluation out of 30 marks at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - (iii) Evaluation out of 40 marks at the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- 5. The students may opt for more than one societies/clubs, which will be considered as their secondary societies/clubs. However, they will not be evaluated for their involvement in those societies/clubs.
- 6. The students getting admission in lateral entry will be required to follow the registration formalities (as mentioned in point no. 2 above). The distribution of marks for those students will be as follows:
  - Evaluation out of 60 marks at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> year (i)
  - (ii) Evaluation out of 40 marks at the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- 7. If the student chooses either GGSIP USS ACM Student Chapter, IEEE Student Chapter as their primary club, then the student has to obtain membership of their professional body (i.e. ACM India/ IEEE India). Also, he/she has to ensure to maintain that membership for all the years of his/her evaluation (i.e. starting 1<sup>st</sup> year till 3<sup>rd</sup> year).
- 8. Faculty coordinators of the technical societies/clubs are also required to
  - Maintain proper documents for the meetings held with the organizing team members of their clubs.
  - Maintain the attendance record of the students participating/volunteering/organizing their (ii) society/club events.
- 9. In order to be evaluated, the student has to ensure his/her active involvement in at least one activity/event per year in the chosen primary club.
- 10. The faculty coordinator of the primary society/club will be required to conduct yearly evaluation of the students involved in their society/club and handover that record to the respective teacher in-charges at the end of 6<sup>th</sup> Semester.
