
Circular

In a significant recent development, Disaster Management has been included as a **subject of UGC-NET Exam**.

CEDM has successfully trained various batches through MBA (Disaster Management) programme since 2005 with participants from Defense (Army, Navy and Air Force), Paramilitary Forces (CISF, ITBP, BSF, SPG, CRPF), CBI, DST, IB, Railways, NDMA, NIDM, Delhi Jal Board (DJB), Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD), NDMC, Delhi Police, Ministry of Agriculture and Ministry of Health, Delhi Metro, CVC, UNDP, Delhi Disaster Management Authority, DRDO, ONGC, GAIL, WHO, Delhi Fire Services and UP Fire Services and Corporate Sector etc. The Inputs for the course are provided through synergic association of experienced University faculty and in collaboration with leading agencies such as LBSNAA Mussoorie, NIDM, NDRF, NFSC Nagpur, Delhi Home Guards, Delhi Fire Services, etc.

National Institute of Disaster Management (NIDM) has “National Disaster Risk Reduction Research Facility”, which provides “**NIDM Doctoral Fellowship Programme**” to offer opportunity for the academicians to get solutions for disaster challenges across country as per details available on the website of NIDM i.e. nidm.gov.in. 


The competition aims to inculcate the spirit of creativity and innovation to students of higher education and ignite and inspire the students of colleges/Universities to innovate and protect themselves from the risk of disaster.

The winning entry will be awarded on the International Disaster Risk Reduction Day, 13th October, 2024.

Detail of video/film making competition

Entries for two month window period (10th July to 15th September, 2024) is open for submission of videos/short film on the following topics and areas:

- i. Earthquake DOs & DON'Ts

- iv. CPR Techniques

Duration: The short film, with a maximum length of 5-7 minutes, are expected to showcase awareness generation on any above mentioned theme related to disaster management.

Selection: The jury constituted by NIDM will select the winner on the basis of novelty and usefulness of the video for **preparedness and awareness generation for DRR**. The video must be original and not previously submitted or showcase elsewhere.

Conditions and format of film:

The following conditions should be noted-

- The maximum duration of the films should be **5-7 minutes**;
- The submissions may be made in acceptable formats such as **WMV, MP4, MKV, AVI**, etc.;
- Submissions should be made in Standard Definition from **480P** onwards.
