- The qualification for Visiting/Guest Faculty shall be the same as those of regularly appointed Assistant Professors.

Selection Process:

- The candidates applying for assignment as Guest Faculty are required to appear before the selection committee with their CVs on **25.01.2024** between 10 a.m. to 02 p.m. The interview will be held in Room No. 207 C - Block, University School of Law and Legal Studies.
