DISSERTATION GUIDELINES

The dissertation of the BALLB/BBALLB X Semester students shall be under guidance of Supervisors allotted to them. The students are required to keep in touch with their supervisors and meet them, at least once in a week, as per the convenience of the Supervisor and the studentconcernedtogiveupdates as to their progress. This year the topics and supervisors have been allocated well in time so that the students have sufficient time to work on their dissertation.

The students are required to prepare **three**hard bound copies of the dissertation — two copiesmust be submitted in the office. One copy should remain with the respective students, whichtheymustbringwith thematthetime of viva.

The students will be required to submit synopsis of the dissertation and one rough draft and the final draft of the

dissertation, which should be prepared strictly in consultation with the supervisor.

This is the final work of 5 years' in the USLLS. Please ensure strict adherence to the research ethics and maintain the highest standards of academic research in your work, which will remain against your name always. The dissertation should be original and free from plagiarism. The University reserves the right to reject the dissertation and initiate appropriate action if the dissertation is found plagiarized.

Final dissertation should consist of the following-

- Declaration by the student about the originality of work
- Certificate issued by the supervisor
- Plagiarism check certificate please refer to UGC (Promotion and Academic Integrityand Prevention of Plagiarismin Higher EducationalInstitutions) Regulation2018.Plagiarism check should be done through Urkundor Turnitin. - Main body of the dissertation should be divided into chapters, with first chapter onIntroductionand lastchapteronConclusionand Suggestions.
- There should be annotated reference list/bibliography consistent with the style of referencing followed, along with appendix. The referencelist/bibliography and appendix should not be counted for the required number of totalpagesofdissertation.
- The main text of dissertation should be of 75 to 100 pages excluding reference list/bibliography and appendix,

Formatting of the dissertation

- Each chapter should have a title, which should be center justified and placed two inchesfromthetop, inuppercase.
- All pages must be numbered with the preliminarypages marked in Roman numbers, and the main chapters, annexures and references/bibliography in Indo-numeric style, beginning from page number 1. All numbers should be placed in the bottom, center of the page.
- Dissertationshouldbetypedin12font size, footnote in 10 font size, with double spacing, in Times New Roman style ,justified alignment.
- Margin of the left should be1.5inches, with top, bottom, and right-handmarginat1inch.

Footnoting and citation should be based preferably on JILI (w.ili.ac.in), 10' Times New roman Style, with single spacing and justified alignment. The style of referencing must be consistent throughout.
