Young faculty members in the social sciences who participate in this comprehensive capacitybuilding program will be better equipped to pursue rigorous research projects, publish their work in reputable journals, and make significant contributions to the advancement of knowledge in their respective disciplines analysis. In addition, this program will facilitate the development of a thriving academic community, fostering collaboration and enhancing the quality of social science research.

Key Components of the program includes

- 1. **Research Methodology Sessions:** Concentrating on quantitative and qualitative research methods and other research methodologies commonly used in the social sciences. Participants will learn to identify appropriate research design, acquire and analyze data, and interpret results.
- 2. **Research Ethics and Integrity:** These discussions focus on critical aspects of research ethics and integrity, emphasizing the importance of conducting research responsibly and adhering to unwavering principles of academic integrity, thereby avoiding plagiarism or research misconduct.
- 3. **Publication and Writing Skills:** Sessions devoted to enhancing academic writing abilities, manuscript preparation, and the publication procedure. Young faculty members will receive guidance on the structure of research papers, the composition of persuasive abstracts, and the publication submission process.
- 4. Data Interpretation and Analysis: Instruction in data interpretation techniques and statistical analysis software frequently used in social science research. Participants will develop proficiency in manipulating and analyzing research data to derive insightful conclusions.
- 5. Networking and Collaboration: Opportunities for participants to network with established researchers within and beyond their institution, fostering potential research collaborations and knowledge transfer.

Eligibility criteria for participants

All those who are working as a Lecturer/Assistant Professor/Young Faculty/ Early Career Researchers in the field of Social Sciences in a UGC-recognized Indian University/Deemed University/College/Institute of National Importance and ICSSR Research Institutes or researchers in social science research are eligible to apply for the course. Limited Seats are available.

Interested candidates can apply for the Capacity Building Programme through a **registration form** or scan before 10 November 2023. The shortlisted participants will be informed by 15 November 2023.

How to Reach GGSIPU

Delhi has good connectivity by Air, Rail, and Road

By Air: All leading domestic airlines operate flights between Delhi and other major Indian cities (Ahmedabad, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Delhi, Hyderabad, Indore, Kolkata, Mumbai, and Vishakhapatnam, etc.). Distance from the Delhi Airport to GGSIPU Campus is about 22 km.

By Rail: Many trains operate on the train route to Delhi daily, ensuring robust connectivity with all major cities in India. The distance from New Delhi Railway Station, Old Delhi Railway Station, Hazrat Nizammudin Railway Station to GGSIPU Campus is about 30 km,

By Metro: The Nearest Metro Station for GGSIPU is Dwarka Sector 14 (Blue line); take the exit from Gate No. 2, and you will get the sharing and personal Autos/ E-rickshaw. The distance between Metro and the campus is 1.5 kilometres.
