NSS Cell of the University is going to conduct the following activities under "Meri Maati Mera Desh Campaign" at the University premises as per given schedule date, time & Venue:

A. Activities for NSS Units from 09th to 15th August, 2023: (Administrative Ground in front of VC office)

The following activities will be organised on any day from 9th to 15th August at every NSS units.

- 1) Dedication of Shilaphalakam/Memorial/Monolith Installation of **nameplate of Veers** wherever possible
- 2) Taking the Panch Pran Pledge (Pledge also available at https://merimaatimeradesh.gov.in/downloads)
- 3) Vasudha Vandan Creation of <u>Amrit Vatika by planting 75 saplings</u> of indigenous trees/species.
- 4) Veeron Ka Vandan- honoring freedom fighters/braves, retired personnel of Defence, CAPF and State forces who laid down their life protecting the nation and families of braves.
- 5) Hoisting of National Flag and singing of National Anthem.

B. Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign from 13th to 15th August, 2023:

As done last year, the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign will be organized encouraging the people to celebrate India'a Independence Day from 13th to 15th August, 2023 where people from all walks of life may be encouraged to <u>take a Selfie with Tiranga</u> and upload it to the website https://harghartiranga.com/.

C. Activities for NSS Units from 16th to 20th August, 2023:

<u>Prabhat Pheris (Morning Walk)</u> may be organized (from 16th to 20th August) in each institution in coordination with the nearest Block/Urban local body (ULB) between 16th— 20th August, 2023 wherein the - Maati (Soil) collected from all institutions or Panchayats may be taken by taking out a rally by holding a tri-color flag in one hand and Maati on the other hand to the identified location at the nearest Block/ ULB for plantation of saplings. These events may be organized in close coordination with State Govt/NYKS of your region.
