1. Copy of Registration Fee of Filled online application form;
2. Valid and qualified fellowship/scholarship from June 2025 onwards in UGC Net/UGC-CSIR Net/GATE/CEET and other similar National Level Tests;
3. 10<sup>th</sup> Marksheets and Certificate;
4. 12<sup>th</sup> Marksheets and Certificate;
5. Graduation Marksheets and Certificate;
6. Post Graduation Marksheets and Certificate. Candidate appearing for the final exam of qualifying master degree may submit marksheets upto the penultimate semester in the following programme:

Master's Degree in Journalism/Mass Communication or related field or discipline or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that educational institutions.

- \* Candidate who qualify for fellowship/scholarship in UGC-NET or other similar National Level Tests can directly apply for admission to the Ph.D. programme in Mass Communication.
- \* Admission shall also be done on the basis of NET Score in accordance with the UGC circular no. F.4-1 (UGC-NET Review Committee/2024 (NET)/1406-48 dated 27.03.2024 (Copy attached).
