**Workshop on Capacity Building of Final Year Law Graduates being
organised by Delhi Judicial Academy**

The **Delhi Judicial Academy (DJA)**, under the patronage of the **High Court of Delhi**, is organising a **One-Day Workshop on Capacity Building of Law Graduates** prior to their enrolment as Advocates.

The Workshop is exclusively designed for **final-year law students**, with the objective of strengthening their **legal acumen, critical thinking, and professional vision**, thereby ensuring a smooth transition from being students of law to becoming practitioners and stakeholders in the justice delivery system. The programme will be held on **20th September 2025 at the Delhi Judicial Academy**.

A total of **25 final-year students of B.A. LL.B. and B.B.A. LL.B. from USLLS, GGSIPU** will be permitted to participate. Upon successful completion of all sessions, participants will be awarded an **e-Certificate of Training Completion**.

The distinguished panel of speakers for the Workshop includes **Former Judges of High Courts, Senior Advocates, Technology Law Experts, and Partners from leading Indian Law Firms**. This is a unique opportunity for students to gain valuable insights and build a strong professional network.

The **concept note along with an indicative module** is attached for reference. A maximum of **25 participants** will be selected on a **first-come, first-served basis**. **Registration is mandatory**, and given the limited seats, students once registered are expected to attend the programme.

Concept Note:

Workshop on Capacity Building of Law Graduates prior to their enrolments as Advocates

- The Governing Council of the National Judicial Academic Council by way of a resolution passed in 2019 had resolved that State Judicial Academies will engage in capacity building of law graduates prior to their enrolment as Advocates.
- Accordingly, with an object to acquaint the participants with the essential skills required for advocacy, the role of an advocate in realising the Constitutional Vision of Justice, and attuning them with concepts of empowerment, legal ethics and use of technology in legal practice, the programme has been meticulously designed by the Delhi Judicial Academy as capacity building initiative for final year law students and law graduates who are yet to be enrolled.
- This programme focuses on enhancing participants' legal acumen, critical thinking and their vision of a legal career, thereby facilitating their successful transition from a student of the law to practitioner/stakeholder in the justice delivery system. The Training Programme is designed as a one-day programme, split across 4 sessions, to be conducted at the Delhi Judicial Academy on the 20th September, 2025.
