The mandate of the IPU-IPR Cell shall be as under:-

- (i) To make aware the faculty, non-teaching employees, Librarians and students about importance and economic benefits of IPR.
- (ii) Sensitizing all stakeholders about diverse aspects of Intellectual Property Rights.
- (iii) Actively promoting faculty and student research by providing support for effective patenting and other forms of IPR protection.
- (iv) Developing a performance related accountability, incentives and rewards mechanism for faculty to disclose, protect and exploit their inventions and help in enhancing knowledge base of the University.
- (v) Creating an Enabling Environment for commercialization of University knowledge base.
- (vi) Leveraging synergistic alliances externally with other constituents of the knowledge chain nationally and internationally.
- (vii) To provide consultancy in patents registration and another branches of IPR.
- (viii) To provide mediation and redressal of IPR disputes.
- (ix) Payments to the resource persons who may contribute to legal and scientific support to the Cell from time to time.
- (x) To organize workshop/conference/invited talks/sensitization programme.
- (xi) Pay honorarium to external members (if any) of IP Assessment Committee (IPAC)
- (xii) Financial requirement for filings patents and other forms of IPR's (as per IPU-IPR Policy)
- (xiii) The Process of monetization of published awarded patents shall be activated by the IPU-IPR Cell.
- (xiv) The Cell shall co-ordinate all IPR related activities.

The above list is illustrative only and not exhaustive one. All functions and incidental & connected issues therewith shall be performed in a cohesive and coordinating manner.
