NOTIFICATION

The Board of Management of Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University in its 90th meeting held on 03.03.2026 vide Agenda Item No. BM 90.34 considered and approved the following guidelines for ‘Multiple Entry & Multiple Exit (MEME)’ for all programmes under NEP-2020:

Guidelines for ‘Multiple Entry & Multiple Exit (MEME)’ for all programmes under NEP-2020

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 introduces a ‘Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit (ME-ME)’ system in order to make higher education more flexible and student-centric, and to reduce the high dropout. This flexibility is allowing students to receive a certificate, diploma, or degree depending on when they exit a programmes and also allowing re-enter the program within a stipulated period to continue their studies from where they left off.

In order to make comprehensive guidelines for ‘Multiple Entry & Multiple Exit (MEME)’ for all programmes under NEP-2020, Committee was constituted and the Committee in its meeting dt. 01.12.2025 framed the comprehensive guidelines for ‘Multiple Entry & Multiple Exit (MEME)’ for all programmes under NEP-2020, which are placed as under:

1. Multiple Entry:

- 1.1 The Multiple-Entry shall be allowed at the end of every even semester (2nd, 4th, 6th, as applicable) in line with the guidelines provided by UGC in this regard.
- 1.2 Re-entry: Re-entry refers to the process of entry into the next level of study by a student already enrolled in a programme of study of the same University School of Studies/Department/affiliated colleges of GGSIPU or from any other University School of Studies/Department/affiliated colleges or any other Universities across India, who exited after completion of the preceding level of study, as defined in the UG Scheme of the respective program of GGSIP University.
- 1.3 Re-entry period: Students can re-enter the same program within three years of their exit. However, the total time to complete the degree, including breaks, cannot exceed seven years from the initial admission.
- 1.4 Admission Process for Multiple Re-entry by -
 - a) The students of same University School of Studies/Department/affiliated Colleges of GGSIP University;
 - b) The students from any other University School of Studies/Department/affiliated Colleges of GGSIP University or any other universities across India

1.4.1 Admission Process: Multiple re-entry shall be allowed to students who seek re-entry to the same University School of Studies /Department/affiliated College of GGSIPU from which they earlier exited or multiple re-entry from other University School of Studies/Department/affiliated Colleges of GGSIPU or any other universities across India with due compliance of the following admission process:

- The University shall determine USS/Institute-wise seats in each programme for multiple re-entry admissions.
- Multiple re-entry shall first be allowed to students seeking re-entry into the same USS/Department/affiliated College of GGSIPU from which they earlier exited. These students shall be admitted irrespective of the availability of seats, subject to fulfilling eligibility criteria in line with the guidelines provided by UGC. If the number of re-entry applicants exceeds available seats, admissions shall be permitted over and above the available seats.
- If seats remains vacant after accommodating eligible re-entry students from the same USS/Department/affiliated College, students from any other University School of Studies/Department/affiliated Colleges of GGSIPU or any other universities across India shall be considered on the basis of:
 - Programme-wise Common Entrance Test (CET) should be conducted
 - Admission should be done through counselling process on the basis of merit/rank of the CET
 - Process should comply reservation/other applicable Govt. norms.

2. Multiple Exit:

The policy provides for multiple exit options at the end of every even semester, allowing students to obtain a certificate/diploma/degree depending on their progress in line with the guidelines provided by UGC with due compliance of Clause 3.2.3 of Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP) and UGC (Minimum Standards of Instructions for the Grant of UG and PG Degree) Regulations, 2025.

- 2.1 A student who wishes to exit a programme after acquiring the requisite credits, in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP)-2020 and in consonance with the Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP), shall submit an application along with the prescribed supporting documents to the concerned Dean/Director of the University School of Studies (USS) / Centre / Affiliated Institute/College.
- 2.2 After due verification of all the eligibility criteria for issuance of Certificate/Diploma/Degree, Dean/Director of the concerned University School of Studies (USS) / Centre / Affiliated Institute/College shall forward the exit-application of the candidate to the Academic Branch of the GGSIP University.
- 2.3 Upon receipt of the application, the Academic Branch shall maintain the records of all exit cases for the purpose of:

- i. Granting re-admission / re-entry to eligible students within the permissible period of seven (07) years from the date of initial enrolment; and
 - ii. Identifying admission slots for the forthcoming academic session.
- 2.4 Thereafter, the Academic Branch shall issue appropriate instructions for the award of the relevant Certificate/Diploma/Degree, as applicable, with the copy to Controller of Examinations, Controller of Finance and concerned University School of Studies (USS) / Centre/ Affiliated Institute/College.
- 2.5 Examination Division of GGSIP University shall award Certificate/Diploma/Degree, as the case may be, after final verification of credit requirement, as applicable.

3. Credit validity:

Previously earned credits are valid, ensuring students do not lose academic progress. The validity period for credits will be as per the guidelines of Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP).

4. Power to remove difficulties:

In case of any differences or dispute in the interpretation or implementation of these guidelines, the decision of the Vice Chancellor, GGSIP University shall be final and binding.

The present policy is in line with the National Education Policy-2020 for seamless and transparent Multiple Entry and Multiple-Exit (MEME).

The above guidelines shall be applicable from the date of approval of the Board of Management i.e. 03.03.2026.

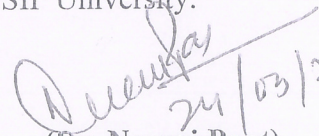
