views of Land & Building Department and Revenue Department may also be obtained. It is, however, submitted that the Land & Building Department and Revenue Department have no role to play in deciding the policy. The Urban Development Department which coordinates the policy relating to land use and mixed land use both in urban and rural areas on behalf of Govt. of Delhi, has already supported the proposal. The Law Department's views also made a mention about ensuring that the instant proposal is not violative of any directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court / High Court in this regard.

(c) Comments of the Finance & Planning Department

Comments of the Finance & Planning Department have been received and they have stated that the proposal concerns matter of policy and they have no objection to its placement of proposal before the Council of Ministers for consideration.

PROPOSAL

22. In the light of the above, it is proposed that the Council of Ministers may:

- (a) permit the institutes located in Lal Dora and extended Lal Dora to run the courses that have been previously allowed and also allow increase in intake in existing courses as well as adding new courses, subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-
 - (i) the institution/society concerned has enough built-up space available at the time of joint inspection.
 - (ii) no new construction would be taken up by the institution concerned on account of adding new courses or increasing the intake of existing courses and there would also be no alteration to existing buildings on this account.
 - (iii) production of documentary proof of legal possession of the premises.
- (b) permit revalidation of the existing NOCs issued to the institutes for the year 2008-09 in the following locations, subject to the condition that there has not been any unauthorized addition or alteration in the course/intake :-
 - (i) Agricultural lands that are not green/other non-conforming areas.
 - (ii) School buildings, provided sufficient provision has been made for operating the school in a separate building/separately partitioned entity, as per revised norms under the Master Plan;
 - (iii) Rented premises in non-conforming areas.
