Prof. Bandyopadhyay,

The Election Commission of India has directed that the summary revision of Electoral Rolls be carried out. In brief, this means that everyone who will be attaining the age of 18 should be given a voter's identity card called the EPIC.

As per the data available with us, there are approximately three lakh students in various Universities and Colleges in Delhi who are eligible to obtain the EPIC and therefore need to be covered under the exercise. To achieve this, we would like your permission and cooperation to carry out the following activities in all Colleges and Institutions under you :

- i) To set up a table with officials / volunteers on Monday 22nd November, 2010 and Tuesday 23rd November, 2010 at or very near to, the main entrance.
- ii) To distribute the application form No. 6 to all students and to receive the same, duly filled in.
- iii) To put up posters at places inside the campus / institution etc.
- iv) To distribute leaflets inside the campus / institution etc.
- v) To provide whatever assistance is required to ensure that the forms are filled in and submitted.

Since the goal of covering everyone particularly the youth with EPIC cards, is a national objective of the Government of India, it is requested that you may give permission for the same.

A Deputy Commissioner / District Election Officer under the Election Commission of India will be contacting you in this regard and he will be the Nodal Officer for the same.
