NOTICE

The admission procedure for the foreign students in the following categories has commenced for the academic session 2011-12.

(i) Persons of Indian Origin (PIO): Persons who are citizens of other countries (except Pakistan and Bangladesh) who at any time held an Indian Passport, or who or either of his parents or any of his grand parents were a citizen of India by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of India or Sec 2(b) of Citizenship Act, 1955 (Act No. 57 of 1955).

(ii) Foreign Nationals: Citizens of all countries other than India, who are not of Indian Origin as defined under PIO

(iii) Foreign Student: Foreign student in this context shall be defined as the student who possesses a foreign passport.

The eligible candidates can apply to the various programmes, mentioned at our University website www.ipu.ac.in under “International Affairs” section.

The last date for submission of forms is **April 25, 2011**. The candidates are advised to submit the forms alongwith documents mentioned below at Kashmere Gate Campus from Monday to Friday at 10 AM to 3PM.

Documents required alongwith Application Form

- Proof of date of birth.
- Certificate and mark sheets of the qualifying examination issued by the Board / University. If the marks are in grading system, candidates are advised to obtain a “Percentage Certificate” from the concerned Board / University.
- Conduct and Character Certificate from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from concerned Embassy.
ALL ABOVE DOCUMENTS MUST BE ATTESTED BY THE GAZETTED OFFICER OR CONCERNED EMBASSY
- Certificate of Medical Fitness to be signed by a Registered Medical Practitioner holding a degree not lower than MBBS in the format as given in Appendix (Refer Admission Brochure).
- Passport and Student Visa **duly attested by the concerned Embassy or Foreign Ministry.**
