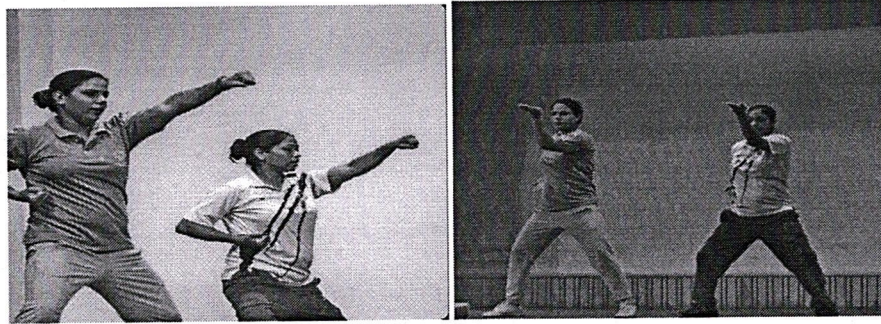
2. **Self-defence Demonstration by Delhi Police -Crime against Women during University Cultural Fest -Anugoonj 2018**
