***This document is notified so that the candidates desirous of admissions may make themselves acquainted with the provisions / rules of admission in MBBS in GGSIPU and University of Delhi and also prepare their documents for counselling well in time.***

1. As per Minutes of Meeting, File No. F.47/P&R/2017/H&FW/2792-2801 (CD No. 112421064) dated 29.6.2017 issued by Deputy Secretary (Med.Edu.), Deptt of Health & Family Welfare, Govt of NCT of Delhi, New Delhi, It is stated that the **Common Counselling for admission in MBBS programme for the State of Delhi would be conducted by Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University for the present academic year.**

***Since this is a common counselling for admission in MBBS in the medical colleges of University of Delhi and Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, any eligible student, in merit, shall opt a seat from among the colleges of GGSIPU and DU, all the students are advised to go through the various notices / Information Bulletin / Admission Brochure of both the Universities and prepare their documents.***

2. Admissions in MBBS for Academic Session 2017-18 shall be carried out by Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University for the following medical colleges in Delhi:-

- (a) Delhi University  
(i) Maulana Azad Medical College

- (ii) Lady Hardinge Medical College (only female candidates)
- (iii) University College of Medical Sciences

(b) Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University

- (i) Vardhman Mahavir Medical College & Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi
- (ii) North DMC Medical College & Hindu Rao Hospital
- (iii) Dr Baba Saheb Ambedkar Medical College and Hospital,
- (iv) Army College of Medical Sciences

3. The Region-wise category wise date and time for 'verification of documents' and 'allotment of seats' Schedule for admission to MBBS shall be displayed on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2017. The tentative date of commencement of counselling is 18<sup>th</sup> July 2017 onwards.

**The Candidate must read the terms and conditions carefully.**

1. The NEET qualified candidates, who registered in GGSIPU, during the stipulated period, for admission to MBBS, shall report in person for Verification of Documents and Allotment of Seats, at the venue of counselling, on the date and time, to be displayed on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2017. The said Schedule will contain the details of Category and Rank of the candidates to be called for counselling alongwith date and time for reporting, details about the dates of reporting in the allotted college, dates of withdrawal, change fee, biometric verification of the students, medical fitness etc.

**2. SEAT ALLOTMENT WILL STOP AS AND WHEN THE VACANCIES ARE FILLED UP.**

**A. GURU GOBIND SINGH INDRAPRASTHA UNIVERSITY**


*Para 3, Para 4 and Para 5 specifically pertains to Vardhman Mahavir Medical Hospital & Safdarjung Hospital*

3. **OPEN FOR ALL CATEGORIES MEANS IN ALL INDIA REGION:-** The All India Region Non Subsidized will include all types of candidates (e.g. Delhi General, All India General, Delhi Scheduled Caste, All India Scheduled Caste, Delhi Scheduled Tribe, All India Scheduled Tribe, Delhi Other Backward Class, All India Other Backward Class, Delhi Physically Handicapped (PH/PWD) and All India Physically Handicapped (PH/PWD) purely on the merit.

4. **OPEN FOR ALL CATEGORIES MEANS IN DELHI REGION :-**The Delhi Region include only type of candidates (e.g. Delhi General, Delhi Scheduled Caste, Delhi Scheduled Tribe, Delhi Other Backward Class, Delhi Physically Handicapped/PWD) purely on the merit.

**5. Clarification on 'Region'**

(a) The location of the 'school/college' from which the candidates have passed the qualifying examination will form the criteria for deciding the Region of the candidates. The candidates who have studied 10+2 (11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>) classes in the recognized School / College in Delhi and passed the qualifying examination from any School / college located in Delhi shall fall under 'Delhi Region Category'.



C (b) The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination (11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Class) from any School / college located in any part of the country (other than NCT of Delhi) shall fall under 'All India Region Category'.

(c) The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from any School / College located in Delhi shall be considered for admission under both 'Delhi Region Category' as well as 'All India Region Category'. This consideration, however, be on the basis of merit of the candidate.

6. **Clarification of Scheduled Caste Category Certificate.** It is seen that some SC category certificates issued by competent authority of NCT of Delhi has a clause stating that this certificate is issued on the basis of certificate of parent issued by competent authority of a State / UT other than NCT of Delhi.

The benefit of reservation shall also be extended to all candidates who hold SC certificates issued from GNCTD provided such caste is enlisted in the list of Scheduled Caste as specified in Presidential Order 1951 as amended from time to time in respect of Delhi subject to fulfillment of other conditions specified therein. Please refer to the Annexure A attached to this notification.

Such candidates whose certificate has been issued by competent authority in GNCTD but their castes do not fall in Delhi, as specified in the Presidential Order 1951 (Annexure A above) shall not be considered for admission against seats reserved for 'Delhi Region Category'. However, they may be considered in 'All India Region Category' as per their merit purely.

7. **Clarification on Other Backward Class Certificates.** Same as above, a certificate issued by a competent authority of Delhi on the basis of caste certificates of his/her parents from another State, will be accepted for claiming seat in OBC category if and only if the caste is in the list of notified OBC list by Govt of NCT of Delhi for claiming benefit of 'Delhi Region OBC'. THE NON-CREAMY LAYER CERTIFICATE SHOULD BE ISSUED AFTER 1<sup>ST</sup> APRIL 2017.

This stipulation of Non-Creamy Layer Certificate after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017 is also valid for the Candidates seeking admissions in "All India Region OBC" in Vardhman Mahavir Medical College & Safdarjung Hospital.

For the Candidates, who shall claim a seat in "All India Region OBC" category, their caste should fall in the Central List notified by the government.

8. For admission to North Delhi Municipal Corporation (Medical College) Hindu Rao Hospital, Dr Baba Saheb Ambedkar Medical College & Hospital and Delhi Region Seats in VMMC & SJH, only the candidates who have studied 10+2 (11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> class) in the recognized **School in Delhi only** and passed the qualifying examination from any school located in Delhi only shall be eligible for admissions.

9. The reservation certificate should be in the name of the candidate seeking admission. The reservation certificate in the name either of parents (Father/Mother) is not acceptable. The name and other particulars in the reservation certificate should be identical to that in registration form as well as in the 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> class certificates. Any variation in the name or other particulars in reserved category certificate may lead to refusal for admission by admission officer in the reserved

category. In absence of reserved category certificate, the candidate will not be entitled for any provisional admission in reserved category on the basis of any undertaking.

The required certificate(s) for reserved categories/classes will be essential at the time of the counselling/admission and no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate. Further, the caste/category certificate should invariably be in the name of the candidate himself/herself and not in favour of respective parents/guardians.

10. **Age.** Candidate should not be less than 17 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017 for MBBS programme. Upper age limit for Unreserved Category candidates is 25 years as on 01/08/2017. However, this shall be relaxed by a period of five years for the candidates of SC/ST/OBC category

11. **Documents required at the time of Counselling / Admissions**

All eligible candidates shall bring the following documents in original along with an attested or self attested copy of the each at the time of Counselling/Admission.

- i) NEET UG 2017 Admit Card
- ii) NEET UG 2017 Score Card
- iii) Copy of GGSIPU Registration Form
- iv) *Four passport size photographs*
- v) *Demand Draft(s) of Requisite Fee in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University payable at Delhi. Details are mentioned below. Write the name of the candidate, name of the programme on the back of Demand Draft (s).*
- vi) Copy of Admission verification form (duly filled by candidate as per **Appendix 4(B) given in Part B, Admission Brochure 2017-18.**
- vii) Preference Sheet (duly filled by candidate as per **Appendix 7 given in Part B, Admission Brochure 2017-18.**
- viii) *Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Certificate for verification of date of birth;*
- ix) **Appendix 10 (A), 10(B), 10(C) & 10 (D) of Part B of the Admission Brochure to be filled by Army Personnel candidates and signed by the competent authority.**
- x) Certificate and Marksheets of the qualifying examination issued by the Board/University from which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination showing that he/she have passed in the subject of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English (core or elective or functional) individually and obtained a minimum 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (40% in case of SC/ST candidates)
- xi) In case candidate wishes to claim seat in Delhi Region category then he/she must bring proof of having passed 11<sup>th</sup> standard exam (under 10+2 scheme) also from Delhi.
- xii) Character Certificate from the head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination was passed or from Gazetted Officer.
- xiii) SC/ST/OBC Certificate, if applicable (Original and One Photocopy).
- xiv) Appendix 1, Part B, Admission Brochure 2017-18 alongwith the relevant entitled certificates, if admission is claimed in Defence Category.



12. **Authority Letter and Undertaking for Authorized Representative.** If any candidate is not able to appear in person for counselling for genuine reasons, he/she may authorize someone to attend the counselling on his/her behalf. But such request has to be made on the prescribed format, Annexure B. Such authorized person shall carry along all the requisite documents along with the demand draft.

13. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION AND SELECTION PROCEDURE:-**

Refer to Chapter 2 "Eligibility Conditions and Admission Criteria" Part A of the Admission Brochure for the academic session 2017-18.

**Eligibility for admission to ACMS for ARMY Category**

The admission to the ACMS is for the children of eligible serving Army Personnel, Ex Army Personnel and War Widows/Widows of the Army. The children of various categories of Army personnel are eligible and they are required to submit the relevant certificate as given against the category applicable to them as proof of their eligibility for admission to ACMS at time of Counselling/Admission.

14. **Region wise and Category wise Seat Matrix for VMMC & SJH, NDMC (MC), Dr BSA Hospital & Medical College and \*ACMS to be filled through GGSIP University Counselling during academic session 2017-18 shall be displayed at the time of counseling. However the following are the affiliated medical colleges, where the admissions in MBBS may be carried out with tentative total number of total seats available in these colleges, mentioned there-against.**

- (a) Vardhman Mahavir Medical College & Safdarjung Hospital -150
- (b) North DMC Medical College & Hindu Rao Hospital - 50
- (c) Dr BSA Medical College & Hospital - 100
- (d) Army College of Medical Sciences - 100

12. **Fee to be paid at the time of Counselling**


(a) At the time of counselling / admission in the University, a candidate will mandatorily bring a demand draft of Rs.30,000/- and a separate Demand Draft of Rs.1000/- (Non-Refundable Counselling Participation Fee) in the name of "Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University", payable at Delhi.

(b) The candidates will pay the balance fee, in their respective allotted college. The candidates, however, may refer to the Fee Structure notified by the University on 14/07/2016 on its website www.ipu.ac.in

(c) The candidates shall be required to pay the revised fee, if such revision takes place.

**B. UNIVERSITY OF DELHI**

1. Minutes of Meeting, as above referred in Point No. 1, File No. F.47/P&R/2017/H&FW/ 2792-2801 (CD No. 112421064) dated 29.6.2017 issued by Deputy Secretary (Med.Edu.), Deptt of Health & Family Welfare, Govt of NCT of



Delhi, New Delhi also mentions that eligibility criteria and other terms and conditions of admission would continue to be applied in accordance with existing statutory provisions of the two Universities. In view of this, all the candidates are requested to get acquainted with / go through Notices / Information Bulletin 2017-18 of University of Delhi.

2. The candidates shall also refer to the Information Bulletin / Notices / Website of Faculty of Medical Sciences, University of Delhi for information on Seat Intake, Surety Bond, list of documents required, horizontal reservation, applicability of certificates etc for admission in the medical colleges of University of Delhi.

3. **Fee to be paid at the time of Counselling**

(a) **At the time of counselling / admission in the University, a candidate will mandatorily bring a demand draft of Rs.1000/- (Non-Refundable Counselling Counselling Participation Fee) in the name of "Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University", payable at Delhi.**

(b) The candidates will pay the balance fee, in their respective allotted college and as per the rules of University of Delhi. For details, may please refer to the University of Delhi website [www.fmsc.ac.in](http://www.fmsc.ac.in).

(c) The candidates shall be required to pay the revised fee, if such revision takes place.

<sup>1</sup>THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED CASTES) <sup>2</sup>[(UNION TERRITORIES)] ORDER 1951  
C.O. 32

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 341 of the Constitution of India, as amended by the Constitution (First Amendment) Act, 1951, the President is pleased to make the following Order, namely:—

1. This Order may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) <sup>2</sup>[(Union Territories)] Order, 1951.

2. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the castes, races or tribes or parts of, or groups within, castes or tribes, specified in <sup>3</sup>[Parts I to III] of the Schedule to this Order shall, in relation to the <sup>2</sup>[(Union territories)] to which those parts respectively relate, be deemed to be Scheduled Castes so far as regards members thereof resident in the localities specified in relation to them respectively in those Parts of that Schedule.

<sup>4</sup>[3. Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph 2, no person who professes a religion different from the Hindu, <sup>5</sup>[the Sikh or the Buddhist] religion shall be deemed to be a member of a Scheduled Caste.]

<sup>6</sup>[4. Any reference in this Order to a Union territory in Part I of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory, as from the first day of November, 1956, any reference to a Union territory in Part II of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory as from the first day of November, 1966 and any reference to a Union territory in Part III of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory as from the day appointed under clause (b) of section 2 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Reorganisation Act, 1987.]
