The University shall carry out admissions of "Delhi Candidates" i.e. the candidates who have completed their qualifying examination (11th and 12th) from any school located in NCT of DELHI ONLY.

The Candidate must read the schedule carefully.

---→ ADMISSIONS WILL BE MADE ON "NEET ALL INDIA RANK" PURELY ON MERIT as per the qualifying percentile of NEET UG 2018.

---→ "NEET ALL INDIA RANK" shall be referred to as 'Rank' further in this schedule.

Important Note about the Horizontal Reservation of Defence and PH/PWD Category.

The seats in Defence Category and PH/PWD Category are reserved horizontally in all the categories such as GEN, SC, ST & OBC and are displayed in the attached matrix.

A candidate claiming a particular seat, shall be required to furnish all the valid certificates of those particular categories. E.g. a candidate claiming a seat in DOBCPH/PWD, must have been completed his 11th and 12th from Delhi, having a valid PH/PWD certificate and also possessing a valid OBC certificate. If some seats remain vacant in this sub-category shall first be reverted to the parent category in Second Counselling.

5. **Clarification of Scheduled Caste Category Certificate.** It is seen that some SC category certificates issued by competent authority of NCT of Delhi has a clause stating that this certificate is issued on the basis of certificate of parent issued by competent authority of a State / UT other than NCT of Delhi.

The benefit of reservation shall also be extended to all candidates who hold SC certificates issued from GNCTD provided such caste is enlisted in the list of Scheduled Caste as specified in Presidential Order 1951 as amended from time to time in respect of Delhi subject to fulfillment of other conditions specified therein. Please refer to the Annexure A attached to this notification.



Such candidates whose certificate has been issued by competent authority in GNCTD but their castes do not fall in Delhi, as specified in the Presidential Order 1951 (Annexure A above) shall not be considered for admission.

6. **Clarification on Other Backward Class Certificates.** Same as above, a certificate issued by a competent authority of Delhi on the basis of caste certificates of his/her parents from another State, will be accepted for claiming seat in OBC category if and only if the caste is in the list of notified OBC list by Govt of NCT of Delhi for claiming benefit of Delhi Region. **THE NON-CREAMY LAYER CERTIFICATE SHOULD BE ISSUED AFTER 31.03.2018.**

7. For admission in ESIC Dental College & Hospital, only the candidates who have studied 10+2 (11th and 12th class) in the recognized School in Delhi only and passed the qualifying examination from any School located in Delhi only shall be eligible for admissions.

8. The reservation certificate should be in the name of the candidate seeking admission. The reservation certificate in the name either of parents (Father/Mother) is not acceptable. The name and other particulars in the reservation certificate should be identical to that in registration form as well as in the 10th & 12th class certificates. Any variation in the name or other particulars in reserved category certificate may lead to refusal for admission by admission officer in the reserved category. In absence of reserved category certificate, the candidate will not be entitled for any provisional admission in reserved category on the basis of any undertaking.

The required certificate(s) for reserved categories/classes will be essential at the time of the counselling/admission and no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate. Further, the caste/category certificate should invariably be in the name of the candidate himself/herself and not in favour of respective parents/guardians.

- vii) Preference Sheet (**duly filled by candidate as per Appendix 7 given in Part B, Admission Brochure 2018-19.**)
- viii) *Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Certificate for verification of date of birth;*
- ix) Marksheets of Class IX
- x) Certificate and Marksheets of the qualifying examination issued by the Board/University from which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination
- xi) Character Certificate from the head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination was passed or from Gazetted Officer.
- xii) SC/ST/OBC Certificate, if applicable (Original and One Photocopy).

10. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION AND SELECTION PROCEDURE:-**

12. **Fee to be paid at the time of Counselling**

(a) At the time of counselling / admission in the University, a candidate will mandatorily bring a demand draft of Rs.41,000/- (including Rs.1000/- (Non-Refundable Counselling Participation Fee) in the name of "Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University", payable at Delhi.

(b) The candidates will pay the balance fee, in their respective allotted college

(c) The candidates shall be required to pay the revised fee, if such revision takes place.

13. **DATE AND TIME FOR REPORTING IN THE ALLOTTED COLLEGE**

All the candidates admitted in 1st Round of Counselling, shall report in the allotted college, latest **by 12.7.2018** positively (as per Gazette Notification dated 05.02.2018 of Medical Council of India).

14. **DATE OF WITHDRAWAL OF ADMISSION**

The allotted candidates may withdraw their admission upto 4.00 PM on 12.7.2018. Such candidates shall visit the Admissions Branch, GGSIPU University, Sector 16C, Dwarka, New Delhi along with their original admission slip along with the prescribed format (Appendix 8 – Form for Withdrawal of Admission – available in Part B, Admission Brochure 2018-19).

THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED CASTES) ²[(UNION TERRITORIES)] ORDER 1951
C.O. 32

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 341 of the Constitution of India, as amended by the Constitution (First Amendment) Act, 1951, the President is pleased to make the following Order, namely:—

1. This Order may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) ²[(Union Territories)] Order, 1951.

2. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the castes, races or tribes or parts of, or groups within, castes or tribes specified in [Parts I to III] of the Schedule to this Order shall, in relation to the ²[(Union territories)] to which those parts respectively relate, be deemed to be Scheduled Castes so far as regards members thereof resident in the localities specified in relation to them respectively in those Parts of that Schedule.

[3. Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph 2, no person who professes a religion different from the Hindu, [the Sikh or the Buddhist] religion shall be deemed to be a member of a Scheduled Caste.]

[4. Any reference in this Order to a Union territory in Part I of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory, as from the first day of November, 1956, any reference to a Union territory in Part II of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory as from the first day of November, 1966 and any reference to a Union territory in Part III of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory as from the day appointed under clause (b) of section 2 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Reorganization Act, 1987.]

NOW the condition of the above written obligation is that in the event the Bounden discontinues the study or after completion of the MBBS/BDS Course of study to which he/she was selected, fails to serve the Corporation for period of three years, the Bounden and sureties shall forthwith pay to the Corporation on demand the total amount of Rs 10, 00,000 (Rupees Ten lakh only) with interest @ 15% towards failure fulfill the obligation. The bond is legally binding on the bounden and the sureties and upon the payment of such sum the above written obligation shall be void and of no effect otherwise this shall remain in full force and effect:

PROVIDED further that the bounden and the sureties do hereby agree that if the Bounden discontinues the study or after completion of the UG (MBBS/BDS) Course of study to which he/she was selected, fails to serve the Corporation for a period of three years, it may be construed as professional misconduct and the fact reported to the Medical/Dental Council of India or of the Medical Council of the State concerned for suitable action including cancellation of Registration by the Council:

PROVIDED further that the bounden and the sureties do hereby agree that all sums found due to the Corporation under or by virtue of this bond shall be recovered jointly and severally from them and their properties movable and immovable as if such dues were arrears of land revenue under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act for the time being in force or in such other manner as the Corporation may deem fit.

Provided further that it is not necessary for the Corporation to sue the bond holder before taking action on the surety, under this bond and the liabilities of the sureties is Co-extensive with that of the Bounden and shall not be affected by the Corporation giving time or any other indigence to the bounden or by the Corporation varying of the terms and conditions herein contained,
