1. As per Letter No. DH&FW/Q015/389/2016/HR/NURSING/E-48441/4905-06 dated 25.06.2018, issued by Section Officer (Med.Edu.), Deptt of Health & Family Welfare, Govt of NCT of Delhi, New Delhi, It is stated that the State Counselling for MBBS is to be coordinated by GGSIPU for the Academic Session 2018-19.

ADMISSIONS WILL BE MADE ON "NEET ALL INDIA RANK" PURELY ON MERIT

This document is notified so that the candidates desirous of admissions may make themselves acquainted with the provisions / rules of admission in MBBS in GGSIPU and also prepare their documents for counselling well in time.

All the students are advised to go through the various notices / Admission Brochure and prepare their documents. The candidate is required to attend the counselling in person.

2. Admissions in MBBS for Academic Session 2018-19 for State Counselling shall be carried out by Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, in following medical colleges in Delhi:-

- (i) Vardhman Mahavir Medical College & Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi
- (ii) North DMC Medical College & Hindu Rao Hospital
- (iii) Dr Baba Saheb Ambedkar Medical College and Hospital,
- (iv) Army College of Medical Sciences

3. The Region-wise category wise date and time for 'verification of documents' and 'allotment of seats' Schedule for admission to MBBS shall be displayed on or before 9.00 PM on 30.06.2018.

The Candidate must read the terms and conditions carefully.

1. The NEET qualified candidates, who registered in GGSIPU, during the stipulated period, for admission to MBBS, shall report in person for Verification of Documents and Allotment of Seats, at the venues so specified in the Counselling Schedule to be displayed on 30.06.2018. The said Schedule will contain the details of Category and Rank of the candidates to be called for counselling alongwith date and time for reporting, details about the dates of reporting in the allotted college, dates of withdrawal, medical fitness etc.

2. SEAT ALLOTMENT WILL STOP AS AND WHEN THE VACANCIES ARE FILLED UP.

Para 3, Para 4 and Para 5 specifically pertains to Vardhman Mahavir Medical Hospital & Safdarjung Hospital

3. **OPEN FOR ALL CATEGORIES MEANS IN ALL INDIA REGION:-** The All India Region Non Subsidized will include all types of candidates (e.g. Delhi General, All India General, Delhi Scheduled Caste, All India Scheduled Caste, Delhi Scheduled Tribe, All India Scheduled Tribe, Delhi Other Backward Class, All India Other Backward Class, Delhi Physically Handicapped (PH/PWD) and All India Physically Handicapped (PH/PWD) purely on the merit only.

4. **OPEN FOR ALL CATEGORIES MEANS IN DELHI REGION :-**The Delhi Region include only type of candidates (e.g. Delhi General, Delhi Scheduled Caste, Delhi Scheduled Tribe, Delhi Other Backward Class, Delhi Physically Handicapped/PWD) purely on the merit only.



5. **Clarification on 'Region'**

(a) The location of the 'school/college' from which the candidates have passed the qualifying examination will form the criteria for deciding the Region of the candidates. The candidates who have studied 10+2 (11th and 12th) classes in the recognized School / College in Delhi and passed the qualifying examination from any School / college located in Delhi shall fall under 'Delhi Region Category'.

(b) The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination (11th and 12th Class) from any School / college located in any part of the country (other than NCT of Delhi) shall fall under 'All India Region Category'.

(c) The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from any School / College located in Delhi shall be considered for admission under both 'Delhi Region Category' as well as 'All India Region Category'. This consideration, however, be on the basis of merit of the candidate.

6. **Clarification of Scheduled Caste Category Certificate.** It is seen that some SC category certificates issued by competent authority of NCT of Delhi has a clause stating that this certificate is issued on the basis of certificate of parent issued by competent authority of a State / UT other than NCT of Delhi.

The benefit of reservation shall also be extended to all candidates who hold SC certificates issued from GNCTD provided such caste is enlisted in the list of Scheduled Caste as specified in Presidential Order 1951 as amended from time to time in respect of Delhi subject to fulfillment of other conditions specified therein. Please refer to the Annexure A attached to this notification.

Such candidates whose certificate has been issued by competent authority in GNCTD but their castes do not fall in Delhi, as specified in the Presidential Order 1951 (Annexure A above) shall not be considered for admission against seats reserved for 'Delhi Region Category'. However, they may be considered in 'All India Region Category' as per their merit purely.

7. **Clarification on Other Backward Class Certificates.** Same as above, a certificate issued by a competent authority of Delhi on the basis of caste certificates of his/her parents from another State, will be accepted for claiming seat in OBC category if and only if the caste is in the list of notified OBC list by Govt of NCT of Delhi for claiming benefit of 'Delhi Region OBC'. **THE NON-CREAMY LAYER CERTIFICATE SHOULD BE ISSUED AFTER 31.03.2018.**

This stipulation of Non-Creamy Layer Certificate after 31.03.2018 is also valid for the Candidates seeking admissions in "All India Region OBC" in Vardhman Mahavir Medical College & Safdarjung Hospital.

For the Candidates, who shall claim a seat in "All India Region OBC" category, their caste should fall in the Central List notified by the government.

8. For admission to North Delhi Municipal Corporation (Medical College) Hindu Rao Hospital, Dr Baba Saheb Ambedkar Medical College & Hospital and Delhi Region Seats in VMMC & SJH, only the candidates who have studied 10+2 (11th and 12th class) in the recognized School in Delhi only and passed the qualifying



examination from any school located in Delhi only shall be eligible for admissions.

9. The reservation certificate should be in the name of the candidate seeking admission. The reservation certificate in the name either of parents (Father/Mother) is not acceptable. The name and other particulars in the reservation certificate should be identical to that in registration form as well as in the 10th & 12th class certificates. Any variation in the name or other particulars in reserved category certificate may lead to refusal for admission by admission officer in the reserved category. In absence of reserved category certificate, the candidate will not be entitled for any provisional admission in reserved category on the basis of any undertaking.

The required certificate(s) for reserved categories/classes will be essential at the time of the counselling/admission and no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate. Further, the caste/category certificate should invariably be in the name of the candidate himself/herself and not in favour of respective parents/guardians.

10. **Age.** As per Part A, Admission Brochure 2018-19

11. **Documents required at the time of Counselling / Admissions**

All eligible candidates shall bring the following documents in original along with an attested or self attested copy of the each at the time of Counselling/Admission.

- i) NEET UG 2018 Admit Card
- ii) NEET UG 2018 Score Card
- iii) Copy of GGSIPU Registration Form
- iv) *Four passport size photographs*
- v) *Demand Draft(s) of Requisite Fee in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University payable at Delhi. Details are mentioned below. Write the name of the candidate, name of the programme on the back of Demand Draft (s).*
- vi) Copy of Admission verification form (duly filled by candidate as per Appendix 4(B) given in Part B, Admission Brochure 2018-19.
- vii) Preference Sheet (duly filled by candidate as per Appendix 7 given in Part B, Admission Brochure 2018-19.
- viii) *Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Certificate for verification of date of birth;*
- ix) **Appendix 10 (A), 10(B), 10(C) & 10 (D) of Part B of the Admission Brochure to be filled by Army Personnel candidates and signed by the competent authority. (for claiming seat in ACMS in the 'Wards of Army Personnel' category)**
- x) Certificate and Marksheets of the qualifying examination issued by the Board/University from which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination showing that he/she have passed in the subject of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English (core or elective or functional) individually and obtained a minimum 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (40% in case of SC/ST candidates)
- xi) In case candidate wishes to claim seat in Delhi Region category then he/she must bring proof of having passed 11th standard exam (under 10+2 scheme) also from Delhi.
- xii) Character Certificate from the head of the Institution from where the qualifying



- examination was passed or from Gazetted Officer.
- xiii) SC/ST/OBC Certificate, if applicable (Original and One Photocopy).
- xiv) Appendix 1, Part B, Admission Brochure 2017-18 alongwith the relevant entitled certificates, if admission is claimed in Defence Category.

12. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION AND SELECTION PROCEDURE:-

Refer to Chapter 2 "Eligibility Conditions and Admission Criteria" Part A of the Admission Brochure for the academic session 2018-19.

Eligibility for admission to ACMS for ARMY Category

The admission to the ACMS is for the children of eligible serving Army Personnel, Ex Army Personnel and War Widows/Widows of the Army. The children of various categories of Army personnel are eligible and they are required to submit the relevant certificate as given against the category applicable to them as proof of their eligibility for admission to ACMS at time of Counselling/Admission.

14. Region wise and Category wise Seat Matrix for VMMC & SJH, NDMC (MC), Dr BSA Hospital & Medical College and ACMS, to be filled through GGSIP University Counselling during academic session 2018-19 shall be displayed at the time of counseling

12. Fee to be paid at the time of Counselling

(a) At the time of counselling / admission in the University, a candidate will mandatorily bring a demand draft of Rs.28,500/- (including Rs.1000/- (Non-Refundable Counselling Participation Fee) in the name of "Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University", payable at Delhi.

(b) The candidates will pay the balance fee, in their respective allotted college. The candidates, however, may refer to the Fee Structure notified by the University on 14/07/2016 on its website www.ipu.ac.in and at the time of counselling.

(c) The candidates shall be required to pay the revised fee, if such revision takes place.
