### Eligibility Criteria -

- Applicable for techies, developers, students and start-ups across the country.
- No constraints on age or experience.

#### **Main Prizes**

- First prize INR 5,00,000/- (Five lakh)
- Second prize -INR 3,00,000/- (Three lakh)
- Third prize INR 2,00,000/- (Two lakh)

#### Rules

- This is a team based competition with team members upto 03 (three)
- Candidates can either invite friends to form a team but they will not add or delete team members after the idea submission round ends.
- It is an online Hackathon in which a team can submit a hack on only one theme.
- The team can submit their hack as many times they want but only the last hack will be considered as the final submission.
- The team is required to mention about all the API's which shall be used while submission of the idea(s).
- The team is expected to come up with new and innovative ideas and any idea that has been found copied from somewhere, shall be disqualified.
- The hack must be developed entirely during the hackathon duration. Open source liberaries and other freely available systems/ services such as Google maps, facebook connect, twitter feeds, etc. can be used.

The submission provided in Baroda Finathon Challenge will be evaluated on :-

- 1. Business potential and Relevance
- 2. Uniqueness in the approach and solution
- 3. User experience
- 4. Functionality
- 5. Scalability, Ease of deployment and maintenance
- 6. Security aspects.
