Description: Research fellowship is available in a research programme “**Tri National Training Program in Psychiatric Genetics**” funded by the National Institute of Health, Fogarty International Center, USA.

APPLICATIONS are invited from qualified candidates who are interested to carry research for 3-4 years. These posts are time limited and the appointment is for a period of 3-4 years or till the project is terminated, whichever is earlier. Salary/ stipend which are equivalent to the candidate’s salary from the university will be provided. The selected candidates may apply for Ph.D. registration to G.G.S. Indraprastha University as per norms of the University. Candidates are advised to check with the GGSIPU for details of PhD eligibility and registration.

Applications from exceptional candidates will be considered, provided they agree to undertake their PhD training at Department of Psychiatry, PGIMER-Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, New Delhi. Candidates will have to work/train jointly at Department of Psychiatry, PGIMER-Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, New Delhi and at the University of Pittsburgh, USA. Each candidate will be supervised by a local faculty mentor/s from PGIMER-Dr RMLH in addition to faculty mentor/s from USA. The candidate will also be trained for 6 - 12 weeks at the University of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, USA. This will be complemented by supervised research, as well as formal and informal training at New Delhi. Flight tickets and accommodation including food will be provided while the trainees are in Pittsburgh.

Candidates will return to India upon completion of training in Pittsburgh and it is expected that they will pursue a research career in India. Candidates selected for the project will be required to sign an agreement outlining the terms and duration of the training, including a requirement for return to India on completion of their training.

Applications should include the following information:

- Complete resume, including details of research experience and publications, and academic record.
- Statement of Research interests and training goals, as they would apply to this program. In your statement also explain to us why you feel you would be suitable for this position, along with your short term and long-term career goals.
- Please outline a brief research project if feasible. This section should not exceed 5 pages.
- Letters of reference from 2 academic and 1 non-academic referee (Scanned copies may be e-mailed with the application, or send fax to 011 23342122).
