Constitution of the Students' Council 2011-12

Please find below the rules/model for the constitution of Students' Council of USS, GGSIP University for the Academic Session 2011-12.

1. The student council shall be formed through indirect election.
2. The Council shall have three representational constituents, viz.,
 - a) Academic toppers from pre-final year of respective courses of USS/University centres/IGIT.
 - b) Elected School Representatives from USS/University centres/IGIT.
 - c) DSW nominated members.
3. The Procedure for the nomination/election shall be as under:
 - a) The students would elect the class representatives in each course. The election would be held according to notified schedule in the presence of faculty members nominated by Dean of the school for the purpose. Subsequently, the Dean of the school would hold a meeting of all CRs for electing a School Representatives/Centres/IGIT and would intimate the result of the election to DSW.
 - b) Only those students shall be eligible for contesting for CR who:
 - Do not have any supplementary/back in any of the subjects of any semester/year.
 - Have no disciplinary enquiry or action taken and pending against them.
 - Have the potential to actively work for the overall development of the University.
 - Have not been detained from the examination for shortage of attendance.
4. Five students will be nominated by the Director, Students' Welfare from out of students of all USS/Centres/IGIT run academic programmes on the basis of the performance evinced by them in different extracurricular activities, sports and management capabilities.

- The above students will be nominated by Director, Students' Welfare purely on the basis of their performances in the relevant fields in the preceding years either in the University or in their previous institutions. Academic performance of students will not be criteria for their nomination to the Students' Council. However, their record in respect of conduct/discipline and potential for contribution for the welfare of the students and the University will be strictly considered.
5. A student each from the final year of the concerned USS/IGIT/University Centres programme who has been pre final year topper of the programme on the basis of combined C.P.I for which the University Examinations have been conducted will be member of the Council.
6. Final Election of the Office Bearers of the Student Council

The meeting of the general council shall be convened by DSW to elect the office bearers. The meeting will be convened in the presence of the Registrar, Proctor, Chief Warden, DSW and Two Deans of USS nominated by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. The Student Council shall have the following Office Bearer:

- i) President
- ii) Vice-President
- iii) General Secretary
- iv) Executive members representing each USS/Centres/IGIT.
