(TOTAL CREDITS: 9)

A. Survey of Related Literature (2 Credits)
B. Supervisor directed courses (3 Credits)
C. Research Seminar (4 Credits)

A) Survey of Related literature

The researcher shall review / survey the relevant literature on a topic of research comprehensively. This shall include a detailed review to be compiled theme wise. This shall help the researcher to identify the research gaps in a given area and understand the dynamics of different research designs.

B) Supervisor Directed Course

Supervisor directed Course shall involve acquainting the research scholars with the use of the tools and techniques of research. The researcher may choose any one of the following exercises:

- 1. Techniques of Sampling
- 2. Development of a tool for research (using the procedure of standardization) e.g. Questionnaire, Interview schedule, Observation schedule, Rating Scale etc.
- 3. Content analysis of studies / Research reports in a given area
- 4 Development of an Action Research proposal
- 5. Preparation of Bibliography on a specific research topic (MLA Style / APA Style)

(C) Research Seminar (Credits: 4)

The researcher is expected to present the progress report with respect to his/ her topic of research.

• Scheme of Examination

- For part A, the researcher will undertake this course as the self study module. The candidate could make a presentation before SRC twice during the period of the course. - For part B, The concerned supervisor shall give the self study module to the individual candidate, from any of the five area mentioned in part B

 The supervisor shall examine each candidate and prepare individial question paper for each candidate. The shall also fall in the NUES pattern. The students shall be evaluated for 100 marks after the presentation jointly by SRC members and supervisor.
- <u>For Part C</u>, The students shall be required the participate make a presentation on their topic in two seminars viz, one internal before the SRC and one final before an expert. The internal research seminar before the SRC would be held on Jan 19, 2011.
