Understanding network security and incident response is not enough for today’s investigative, intelligence, and response professionals. These individuals must be able to locate, secure, and complete offsite forensic analysis. This Training Program is designed to fulfill this role. This Training give an intensive introduction to forensic computing geared toward Delhi Police officials.

In training, Sessions will be conducted by Faculty of University School of IT, Law Professionals, Scientists from NIC, computer forensics Experts from Asian School of cyber Law, Appin Tech., AKS IT solutions, Fostering Linux etc... Including senior officials of the Special Cell of Delhi Police.

Technical sessions will be supplemented by extensive hands-on labs. Whole training program of 6 Weeks is divided into two groups of 4 weeks and 2 weeks. In first 4 Weeks , Participants will be made familiar with basic software, hardware operating systems and networking technology. Backgrounds in IP networking, Linux, and Windows and in the remaining 2 Weeks they will be trained in what forensic computing is? , how to conduct electronic discovery? , how to analyze data collected? And how to prepare evidence reports and IT act 2000 in the context of cyber crime?
