

B.Tech – MBA Dual Degree Programme
Admission Notice (Academic Year 2010-11)

University School of Management Studies, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, Kashmere Gate, Delhi, invites applications for admissions to its prestigious B.Tech-MBA Dual Degree Programme for the Academic Year 2010-2011.

Eligibility: Admissions are open only to the students who are in their 4th Semester of B.Tech Programmes and studying in the University schools including IGIT.

Intake: Total numbers of seats available are 60 and shall be distributed among various branches of B.Tech Programme in proportion of the number of students in 4th Semester of respective programmes.

Selection Criteria: Admissions shall be made in the order of merit determined on the basis of marks secured by the eligible students in their 1st and 2nd semester examinations of the B.Tech Programme. Students from a particular branch will be considered only against the seats allocated to that particular branch. However, the unfilled seats out of the allotted seats for a particular branch will be filled by the eligible students of other branches on the basis of merit without any regard to the branch.

Fees: Admitted students are required to pay annual fee of Rs.5000/- (exclusive of the fee to be paid by them for their B.Tech programme) in their 3rd year and 4th year. The fee to be paid in the 5th year of the programme shall be equivalent to the fee paid by the MBA final year students in that academic year.

Last Date: The last date for submission of applications is July 10, 2010. The University reserves right to consider applications submitted after the last date provided there are any vacant seats.

Salient Features:

Opportunity to secure B.Tech & MBA degree in five years.
Option to exit at the end of 4th year with a certificate in management.

Scheme: Student admitted to the program will be offered a minimum of two courses in Management discipline in every semester starting from 5th semester of their B.Tech-MBA programme. Exemption may be granted in respect of courses that are covered under scheme of syllabi of their respective B.Tech programme provided such courses or equivalent courses are cleared by the students in their respective B.Tech programmes. Those students who are not eligible for exemption of management courses will be offered courses in addition to the minimum two courses. In the 9th and 10th semester of B.Tech – MBA Programme the students are required to take 7 and 6 courses respectively which interalia includes courses from major and minor specializations.

Classes for the courses offered in the Management subjects will be held two days in a week including weekends.
