JEE Main Paper-1/ CET qualified Candidates:

The candidates who wish to seek admission to B. Sc./ M. Sc. dual degree (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) may also report on 03.09.2026 (Thursday) from 09.30 a.m. onwards. JEE main qualified candidates are required to pay the Registration Fee i.e. 2500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred Only) (Non Refundable), if not paid, through a bank draft in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University or through online mode on the spot.

CUET qualified Candidates:

Any candidate who had registered earlier but due to any reason not deposited the registration fee of Rs.2500/- and is interested in getting admitted to B.Sc./ M.Sc. dual degree (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) may also report on 03.09.2026 (Thursday) from 09.30 a.m. onwards. Such candidates are required to pay the Registration Fee i.e. 2500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred Only) (Non Refundable) through a bank draft in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University or through online mode on the spot.

12th Pass Candidates: (Who could not attend in any entrance test)

Any candidate who wish to seek admission to B.Sc./ M.Sc. dual degree (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) may also report on 03.09.2026 (Thursday) from 11.30 a.m. onwards. Such candidates are required to pay the Registration Fee i.e. 2500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred Only) (Non Refundable) through a bank draft in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University or through online mode on the spot. The allotment of seat will be offered after verification of documents and on the basis of merit of candidates, who will be present on the same day.

Important:

1. Allotment of seats in B. Sc./ M. Sc. dual degree in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics will be done on the basis of Joint Entrance Exam [JEE] Main Paper-I/ CET/ CUET/12th Merit Base as per eligibility criteria mention in point No. 3 below.
2. Allotment of Seats will stop as and when the seats get filled up.
3. **Eligibility Criteria for B.Sc./M.Sc. (Physics & Mathematics):-** Candidates must have passed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognized by the concerned state/central government and education board with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and English individually. Further, the student should have obtained 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics in the aforesaid qualification examination in the case of General Category. For reserved category relaxation of marks will be as per the University policy.

Eligibility Criteria for B.Sc./ M.Sc. (Chemistry):- Candidates must have passed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognized by the concerned state/central government and education board with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics OR Biology and English individually. Further, the student should have obtained 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics OR Biology in the aforesaid qualification examination in the case of General Category. For reserved category relaxation of marks will be as per the University policy.

The language: Instead of English if the student has any other Vernacular language as first language, that language may be considered in place of English, provided that is allowed by University norms.

4. **Offline Counselling Procedure**

5. **Fee**

Bank Draft(s) of Rs.1,14,150/- is required at the time counselling in favour of Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, payable at Delhi. The candidate will write his/her name, date of admission, phone, address, mobile no, name of the programme, JEE/ CET Rank/CUET Rank and JEE/ CET/CUET Roll Number on the back of the Bank Draft(s). Balance fee (if applicable) shall be paid by the candidate at the allotted institute.

Documents Required for Verification and Allotment of Seats (alongwith a set of photocopies):

- a) Four passport sized photographs
- b) JEE/ CET/CUET Rank Card/ Merit Order of CET/CUET-2026 (copy)
- c) JEE/ CET/CUET -2026 Admit Card (in original).
- d) Filled Admission verification form as per Appendix 6 of Part F of Admission Brochure 2026-27.
- e) Filled Preference sheet as per Appendix 10 of Part F of Admission Brochure 2026-27.
- f) Proof of date of birth (Secondary School Mark-sheet & Certificate) (Original and Photocopy)
- g) **Mark-sheets / Certificates of qualifying examination:**
The candidate will be required to bring the Original certificates/Mark-sheets of all the year wise or semester wise in original along with photocopy of Certificates/ Mark-sheets of qualifying examination.
- h) **For Distance / Open Learning Cases:**
In case of students who have passed the qualifying examination through distance / open education system of any recognized University / Board / Institution, the necessary documentary evidence related to location of his / her study centre i.e. study centre proof, certificate from the University imparting open / distance education certifying the location of the study centre to be submitted.
- i) **Physical Fitness Certificate:**
All the students shall be required to submit a Medical Certificate indicating fitness from a Registered Medical Practitioner as per format given in Performa of Medical Certificate in given in Part-F in Admission Brochure 2026-27 (As per Appendix 4).

6. It will also be the sole responsibility of the candidates themselves to make sure that they are eligible and fulfill all the conditions prescribed for admission. Before filling-up the verification slip at the time of verification of documents/counselling/allotment of seats, candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils all eligibility conditions as laid down in the respective Admission Brochure for the session 2026-27. If it is found at any stage during the entire period of the programme that the candidate does not fulfill the requisite eligibility conditions, his/her admission will be cancelled and also disciplinary action will be initiated against his/her and entire fee will also be forfeited.
